Program

- Founded in 1991, Bronte College is a coeducational, private high school offering Grades 9 to 12 for day and boarding students. Bronte students graduate with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and may also choose to apply for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, or take Advanced Placement (AP) allowing students to transfer credits to universities and colleges. Bronte College is an inspected private school and is authorized to grant Ontario Secondary School credits by the Ontario Ministry of Education.
- Committed to academic excellence and individual growth, Bronte College offers small classes, supportive teachers, and a variety of extracurricular activities to provide students with a holistic learning experience. Focused on university preparation and achieving success at the post-secondary level, 98% of Bronte graduates are accepted to top Canadian and world universities.

Facility

- School enrollment includes approximately 400 students from 30 different countries, including both local and international students. Small class sizes allow for greater teacher support. Full size facilities include a library, gymnasium, fitness facility, outdoor playing field and 25 classrooms with SMART board technology. Boarding facilities include recently renovated washrooms and common areas, brand new laundry rooms and elevators. There is room for over 350 students, organized onto male floors and female floors. Each floor is overseen by a senior student don and monitored closely by video cameras and 24 hour security

ESL

- Bronte College does not require IELTS scores. Student will be provided links to online testing, and placed into ESL classes if required. Bronte College's ESL program is integrated into the regular timetable so students benefit from English immersion.

Accommodations

- Bronte's campus is located in the heart of Mississauga, one of the safest cities in Canada, and a short drive to downtown Toronto. Bronte offers two accommodation options to boarding students: residence and homestay. Bronte's comfortable and secure residence is conveniently located in the same building as the school, with single, double, and quad room options. A full meal plan in Bronte's full-service cafeteria, open 365 days a year, is included in residence fees. Bronte College accommodations remain open for students over the December and March holidays at no additional cost.
- Bronte College organizes its own Homestay program, with carefully screened host families, and students are supported by an on-campus Homestay coordinator. All meals are included in Homestay fees, including hot lunch in the cafeteria, and breakfast and dinner with the host family. School bus transportation is also included.



Activities

- On campus residence staff provide day and evening support to students, oversee evening study sessions, and organize social activities such as cooking classes and sporting events.
- Teaching staff are available for afterschool instruction, and organize a wide array of extracurricular clubs. Sports include soccer, badminton, basketball, table tennis, volleyball, cross-country, track and field, and dance.
- The Residence Life program includes weekend trips to local tourist attractions, seasonal events and sporting activities.

Intakes and Tuition fees

- Bronte College has 3 intakes: September, February, and July, as well as fun, educational summer camps for students 12-17 years of age.
- Grades 9 to 11 (8 credits): CAD 19,800 (2 semesters/one school year)
- Grade 12 (6 credits): CAD 16,500 (2 semesters/one school year)
- English language support program (110 hours instruction): 2,950 CAD
- Grade 11 for IB program: 20,625 CAD (2 semesters/one school year)
- Year 12 for IB program: 22,000 CAD (2 semesters/one school year)
- Accommodation (10 months, meals included) ranges from CAD 14, 200 – 18,000.
- Summer camp, 2, 3 and 4 week sessions from CAD 3,750
