## ONTARIO PROVINCIAL UPDATES

Ontario has announced nearly all businesses and public spaces will reopen in Stage 3 of reopening the province. **Peel Region will move into Stage 3 this Friday July 31.** This is wonderful news as it means Ontario has brought the Pandemic to a level where cases are fewer and now all places of business will be allowed to open under strict Public Health Regulations.

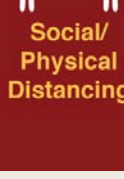


**Wear Face Mask**

Upon returning to the school, students must sanitize their hands, wear their mask and have their temperature taken and recorded by Front Desk staff.



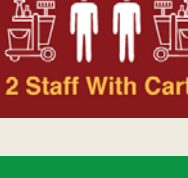
**Wear Face Mask**

## DRESS CODE POLICY FOR FACE MASKS



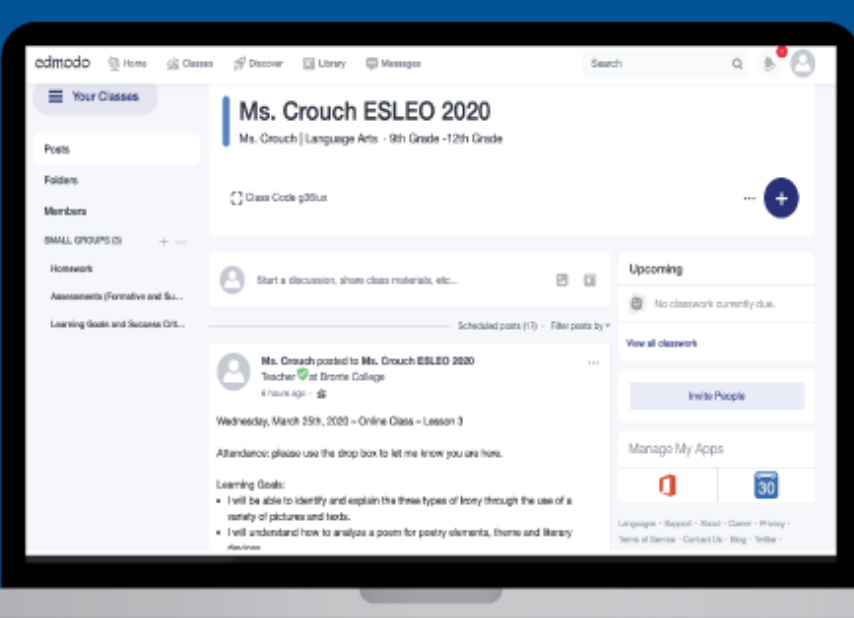
To ensure that masks are appropriate and respectful, the following policy applies:
