- Effective July 2, it will be mandatory to wear a mask when travelling on MiWay and other public transportation. For more information click [here](#).

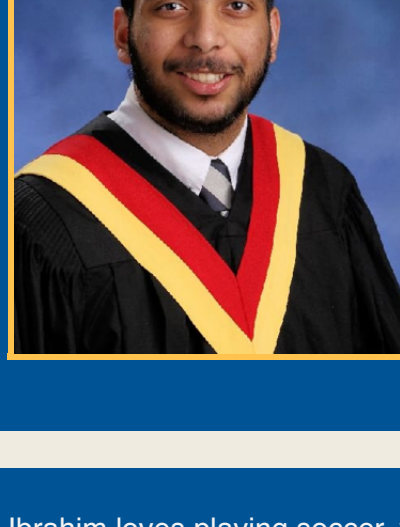


## A SHOUT OUT TO
