This year we are offering 3 summer programs; Summer School, Summer Workshops and Summer Residence Activities.

In accordance to the Ontario Ministry of Education, Bronte College is now offering Grades 9 to 12 students an opportunity to upgrade course marks over summer break. We strongly suggest our students consider taking advantage of this opportunity, as the Ontario government may not permit this expanded summer learning program to be offered again in following years. The upgrading course option will be offered in a 55-hour learning format that may include remote teacher-led learning while emergency measures continue. Please note courses will only be available if there are sufficient numbers of students.
