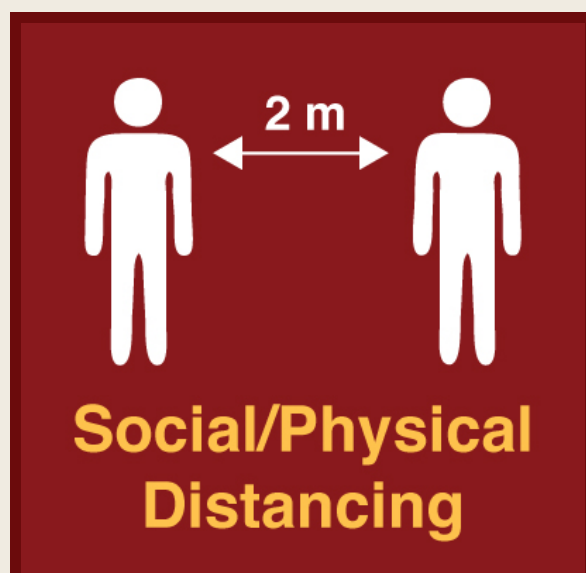
PROTOCOLS FOR ENTERING THE BUILDING

Students will be reminded to practice physical distancing, hand sanitization and further instructions via signage posted around campus and word of mouth.

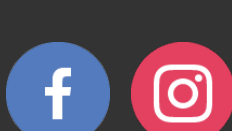
