Dear Bronte Community,

Bronte College continues to work to keep our staff and students safe; maintaining zero cases of COVID-19 and zero suspected cases among the Bronte Community. It is our intention to continue to make decisions based on the health and safety of our students and staff. That is why we will be returning to the following protocols:

1. Effective Wednesday September 30th, students will no longer be allowed to leave Bronte College property. We encourage students to shop online, while following the campus delivery protocols. Students are required to sanitize their packages and hands upon accepting deliveries. See below for package arrival steps.
2. Only essential staff will be allowed to enter the building and will be medically screened upon entry.
3. Students in residence will continue to attend classes face-to-face.

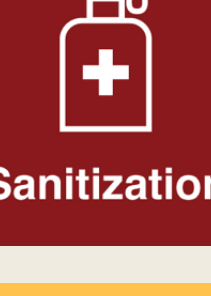

before tapping your student card to pick up the package/delivery

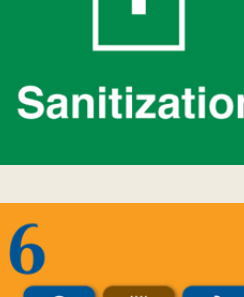

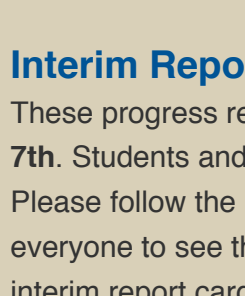

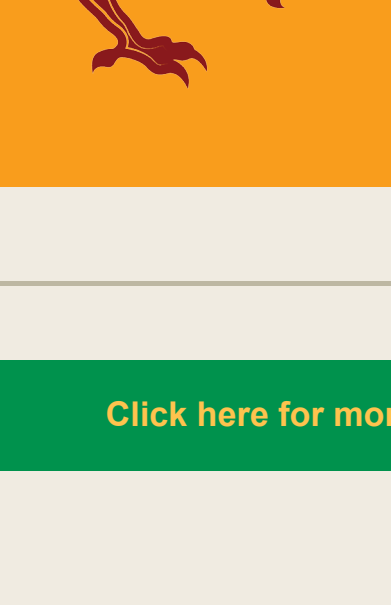
Virtual University Fair at Bronte College:

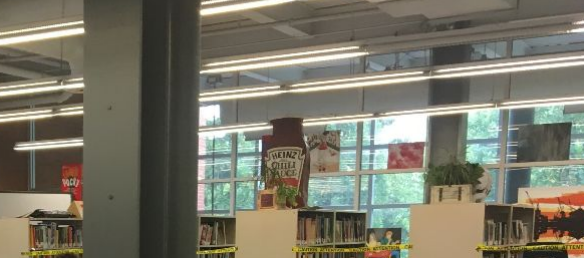

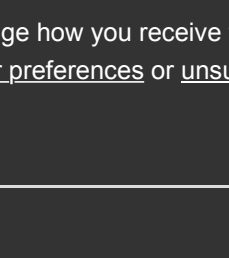
