AMERICAN THANKSGIVING CELEBRATION

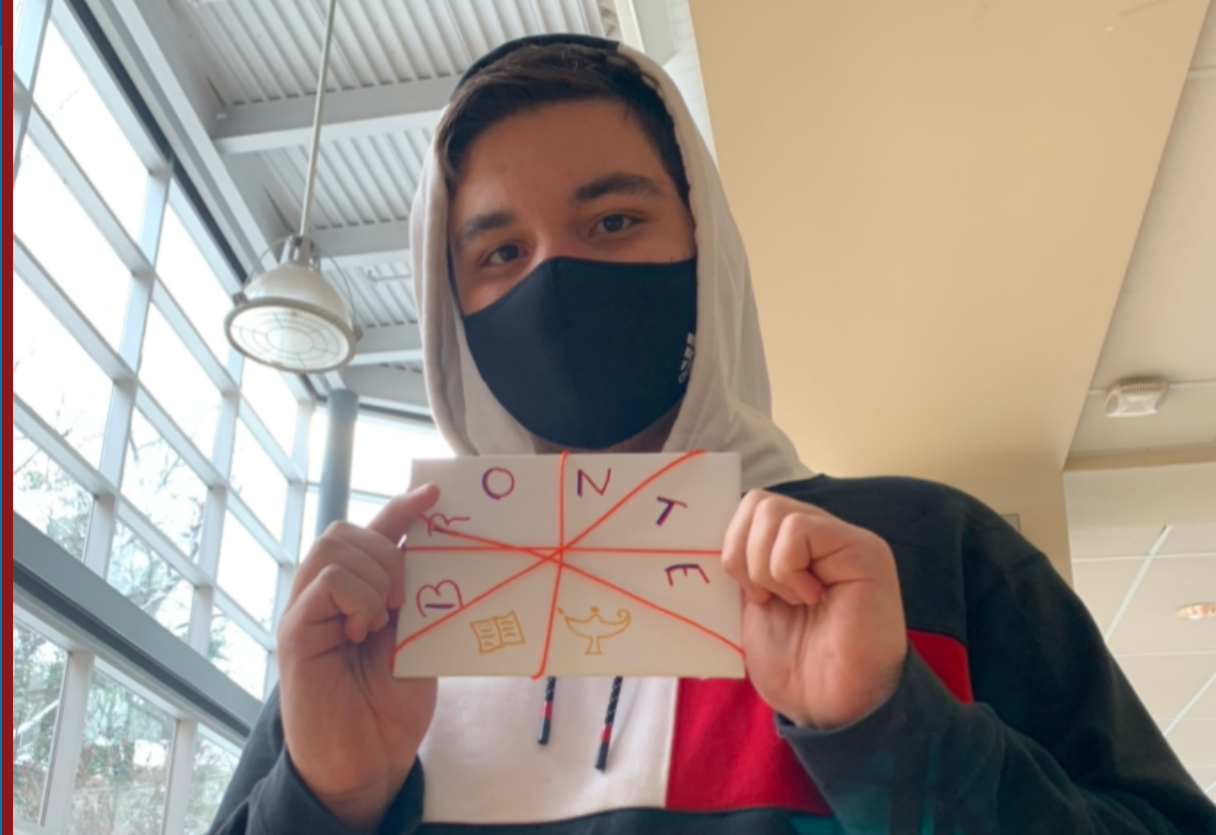
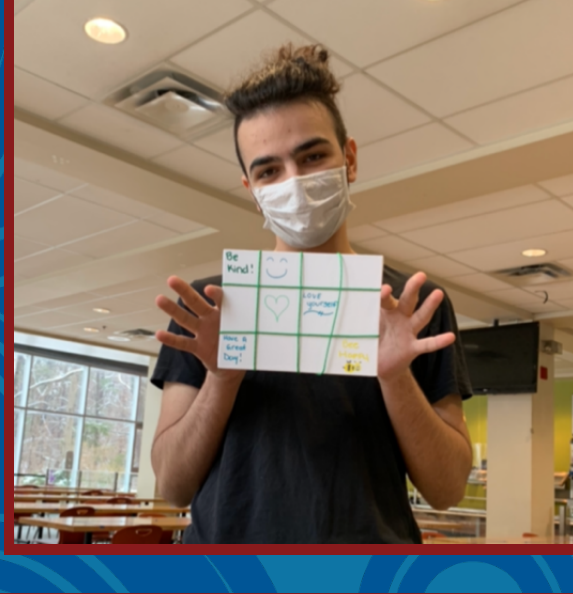

- offer clarification around document uploads regarding study permits

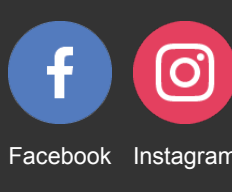
