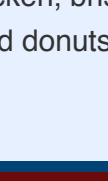

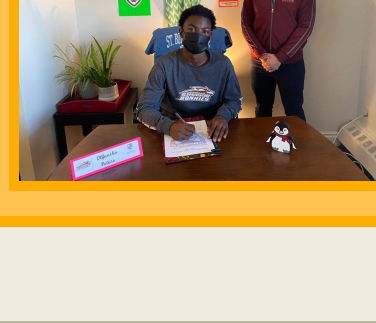
CONGRATULATIONS FUNSHO!

TRAVELLING TO CANADA REMINDER

If you are travelling to Canada by air; it is now **mandatory** to use ArriveCAN to submit your information digitally before you board your flight. Students will be required to submit their contact and travel information, their quarantine plan, and a COVID-19 symptom self-assessment. Students must be ready to show their ArriveCAN receipt when seeking entry into Canada; a border services officer will verify that information has been submitted digitally.

Required documents will be sent to students upon receipt of flight information.

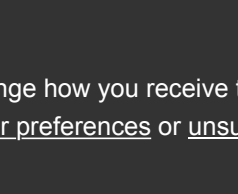
