A huge shoutout to all the wonderful women on our campus that help keep Bronte College a safe, engaging and exciting place to be!

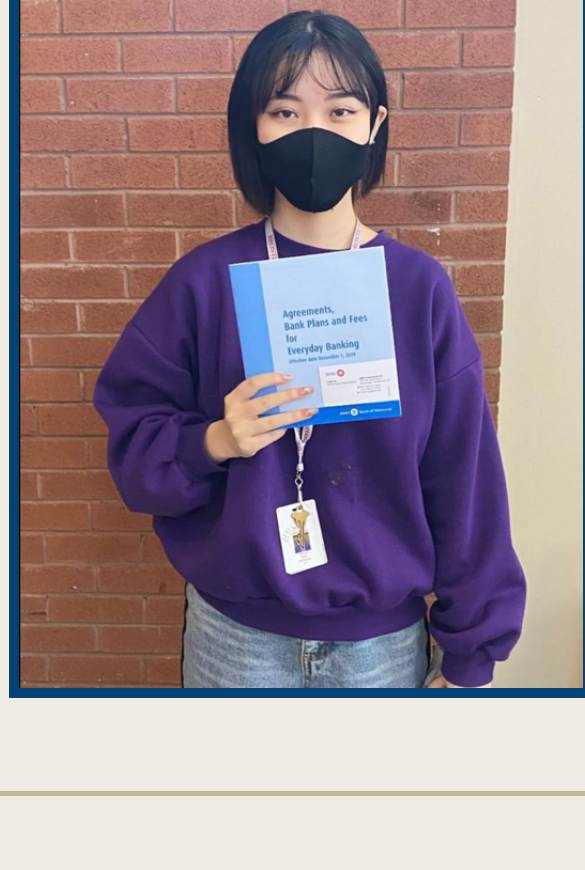
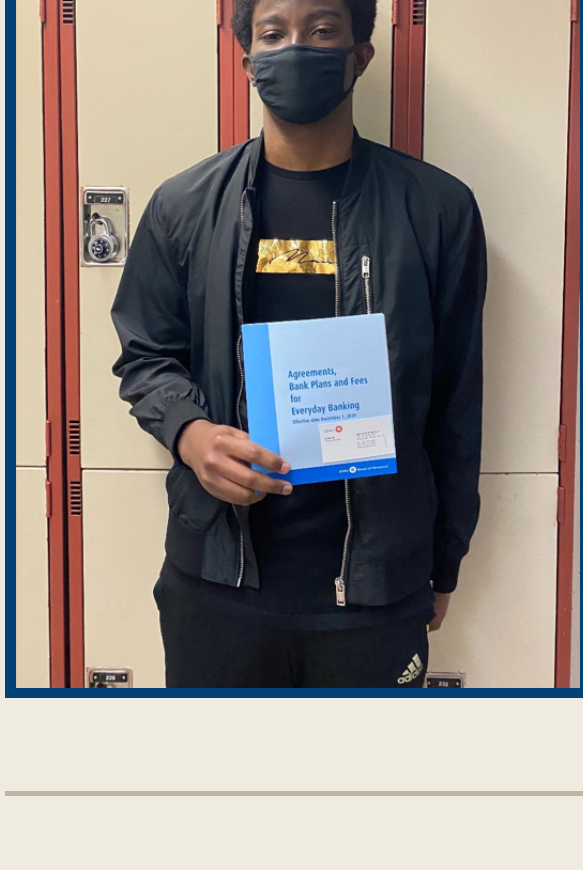
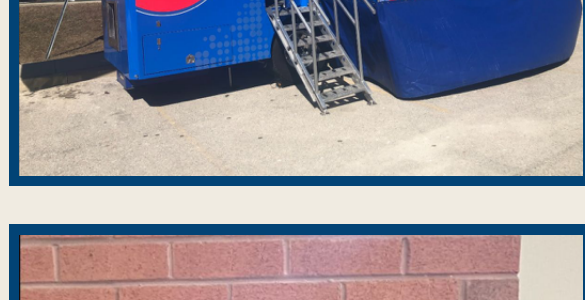
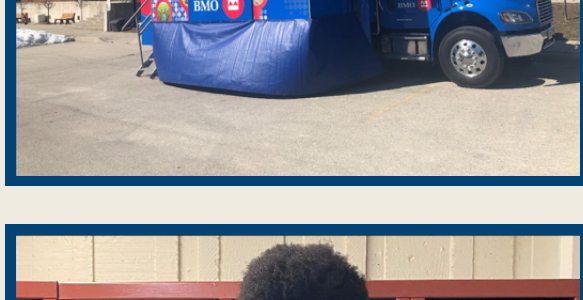
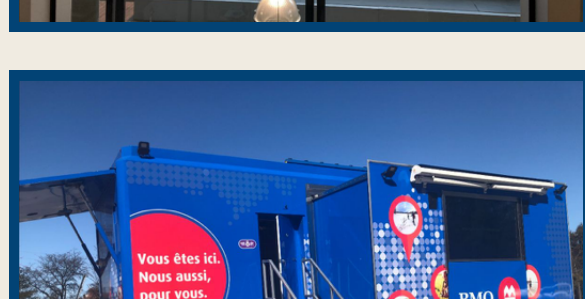
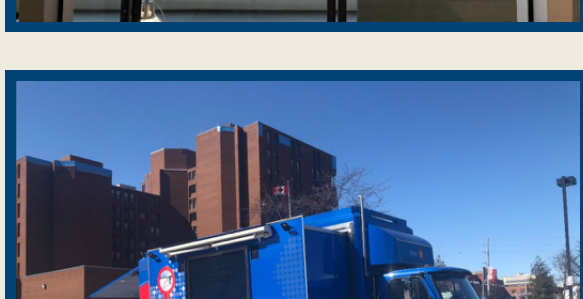
WHAT'S HAPPENING ON CAMPUS

A reminder to our students that Daylight Savings will be occurring on **March 14th, 2021**. Clocks will move forward **1 hour!**

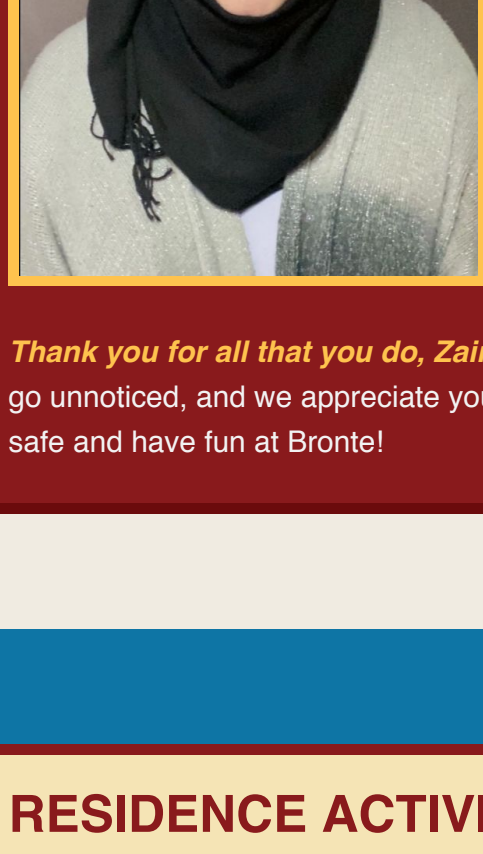


GUIDANCE NEWS

A SHOUT OUT TO *Zainab!*



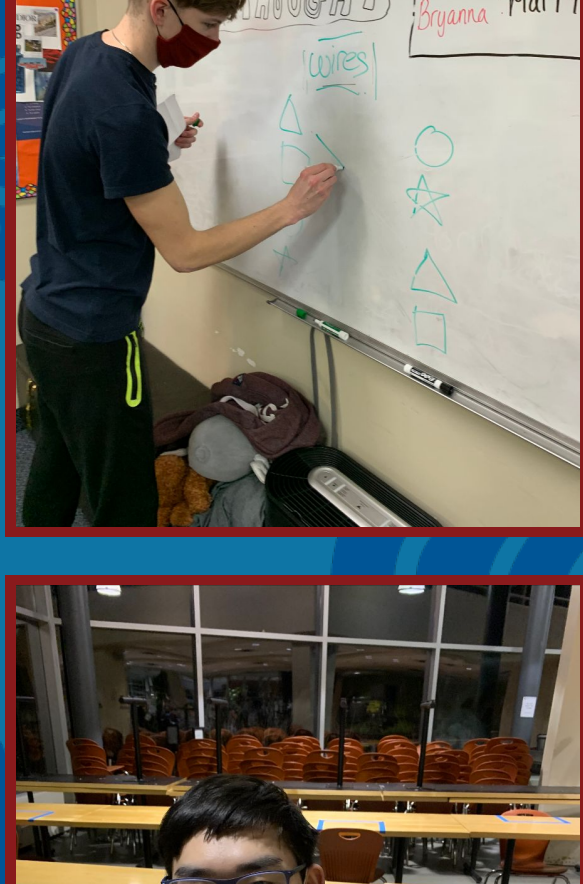
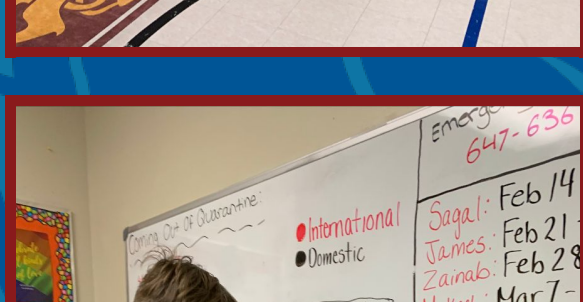
