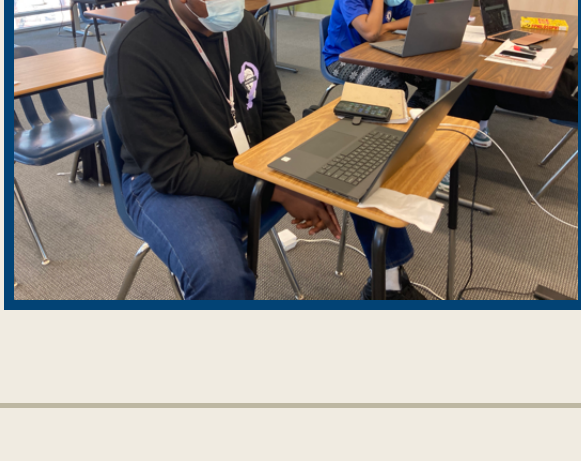
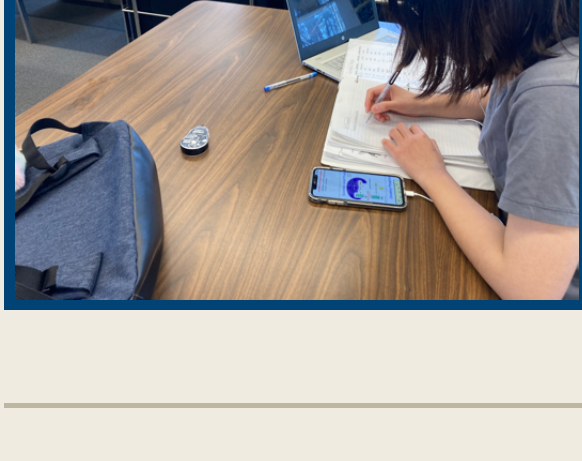
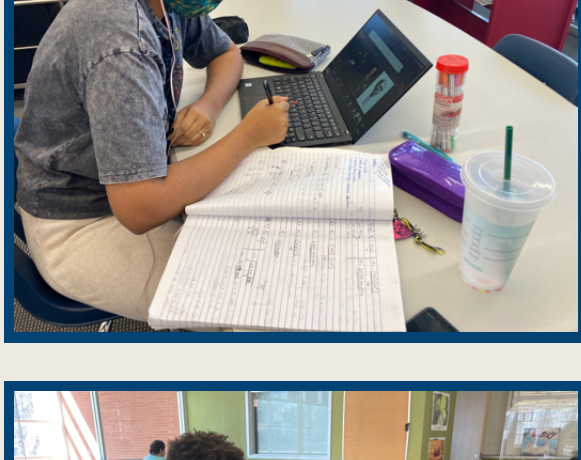
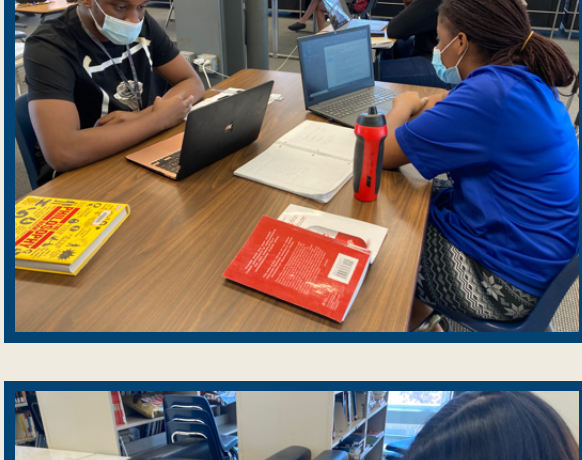
Dear Bronte Community,

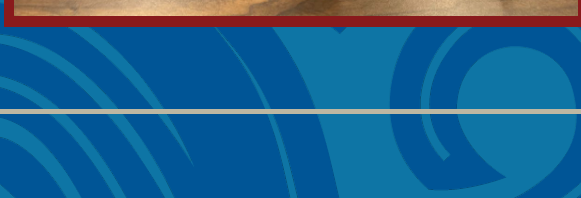
GUIDANCE NEWS

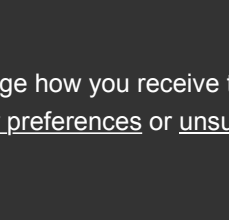
