Dear Bronte Community,

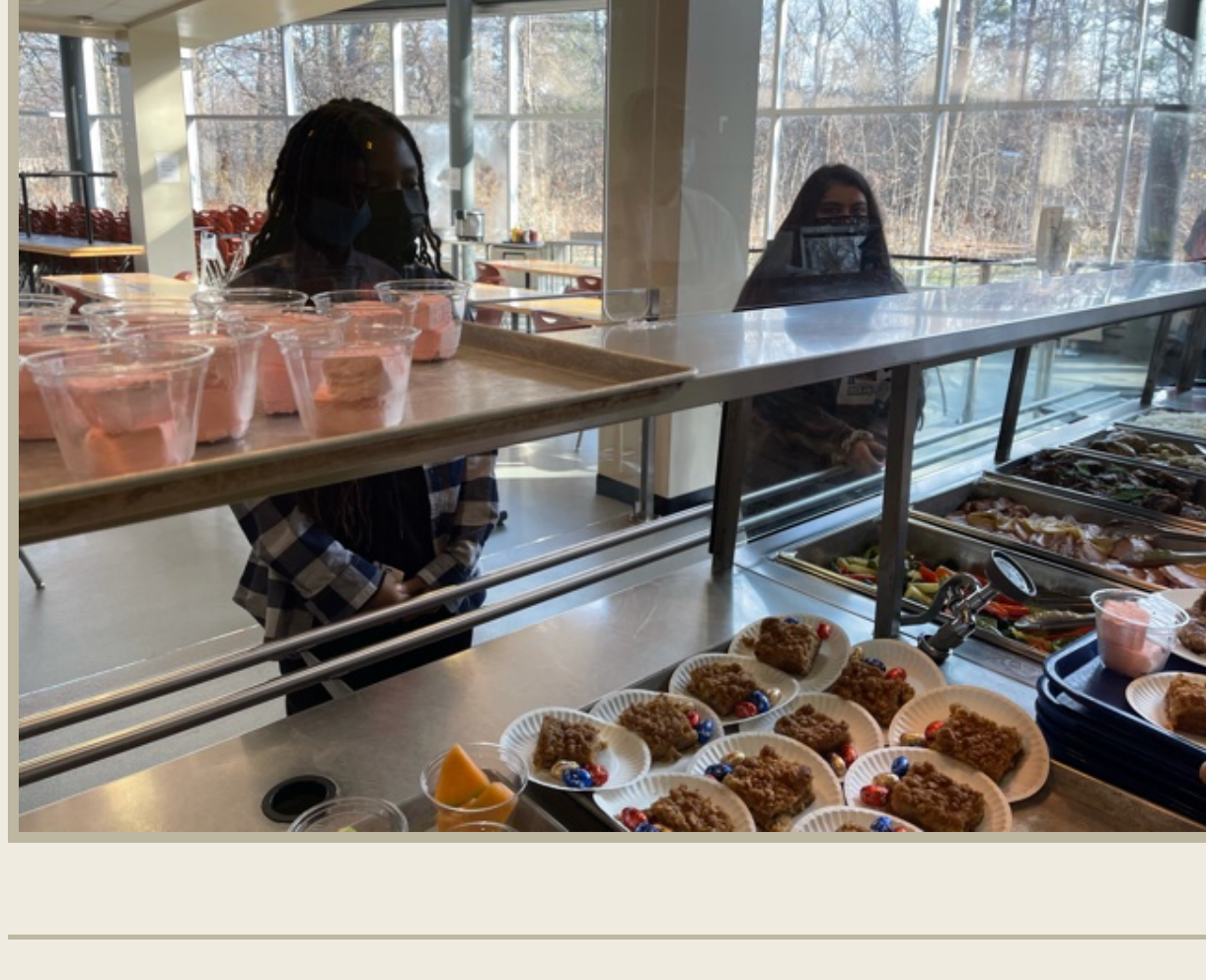
Bronte College continues to value the safety of our community and will continue the online program when students return on Monday, April 12th. We are proud of our decision to continue with this format of teaching and learning currently.

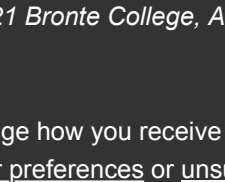
