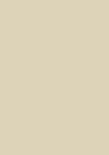

The Ontario government has announced that children 12 years of age and older will be eligible to register for their COVID-19 vaccinations, beginning May 31st. International students will also be eligible for their vaccinations commencing the first week of June.

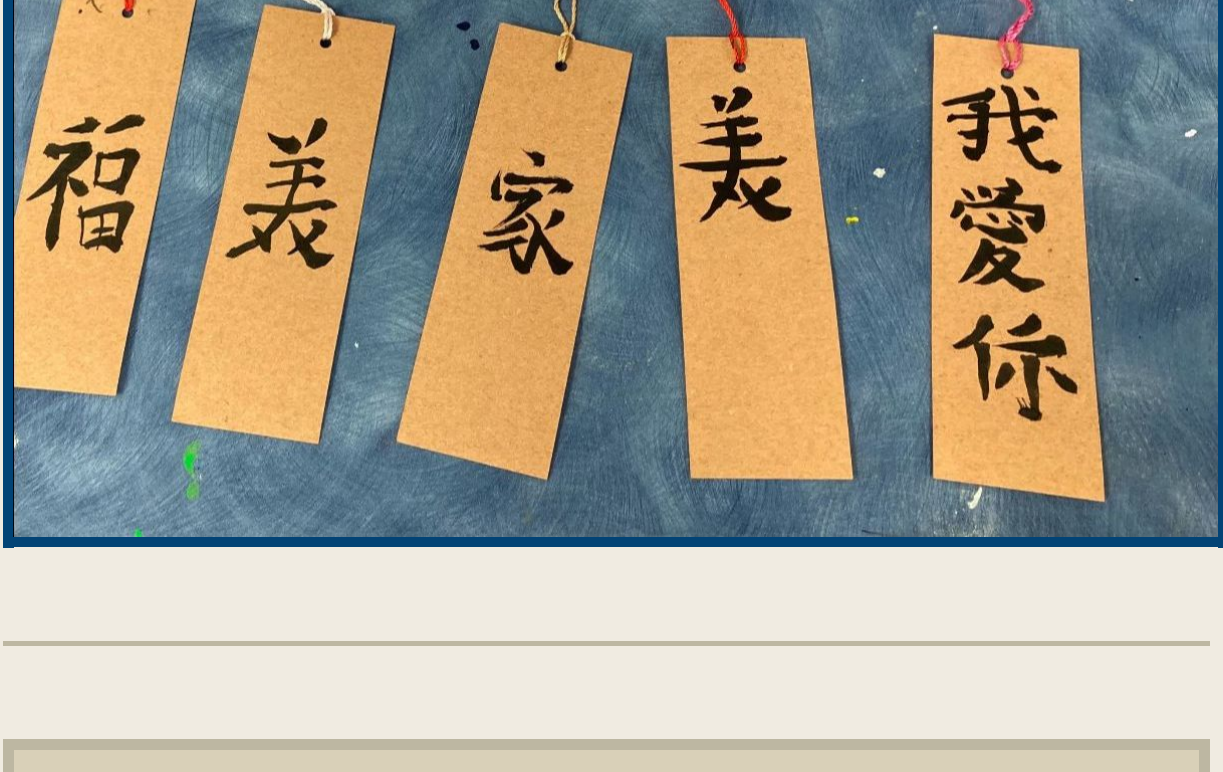
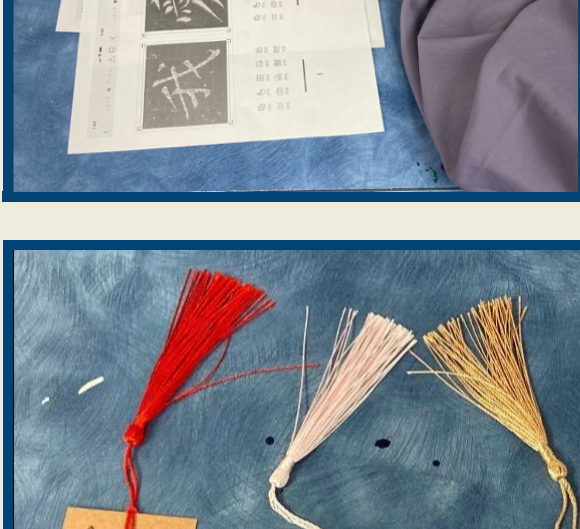

You then went to a waiting room for 15 minutes and if no side effects occurred you were allowed to leave. I am scared of needles but it did not hurt and you could not really feel it! Overall, it was totally worth it and hopefully we will be able to get back to normal life really soon!"

GUIDANCE NEWS

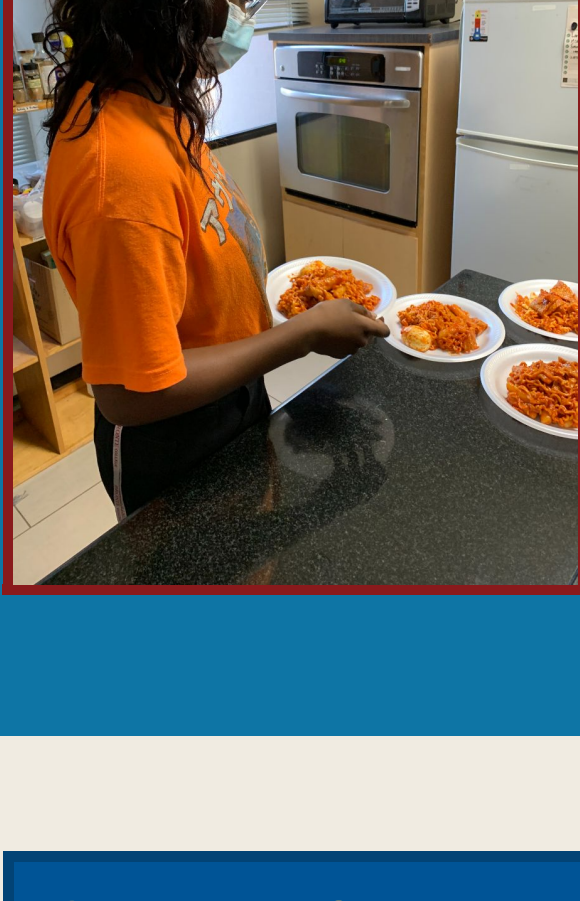
The latest date all high school applicants who submitted their application by the January application deadline can **expect a response** from an Ontario university is **May 27, 2021**. This includes: an offer of admission; a refusal; or a deferral, once additional information is received.

The earliest date an Ontario high school student may be **required to respond** to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a **financial commitment** (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.) is **June 1, 2021**. All other admissions-related elements, including scholarships, other forms of student assistance or financial incentives, and offers of residence are considered part of the offer of admission. A student may accept these other offers before June 1, 2021, but Ontario universities will not require a student in any way to make a decision earlier than this date.

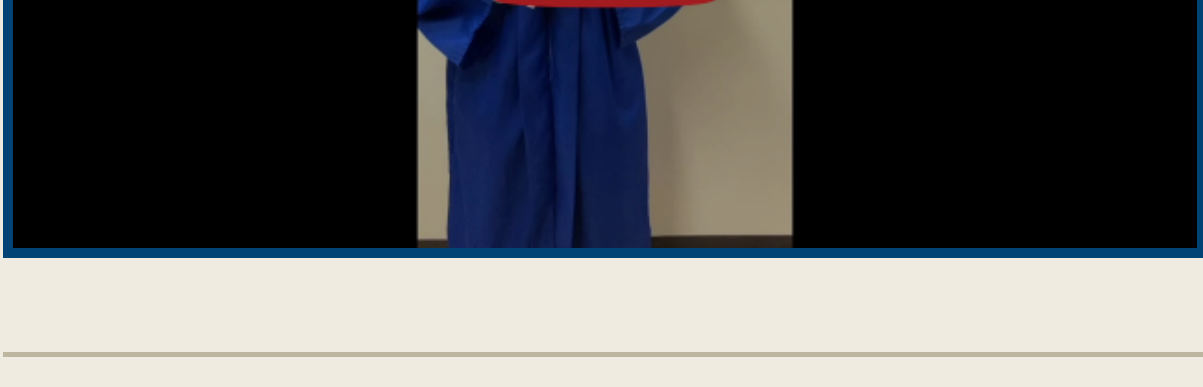
RESIDENCE LIFE
