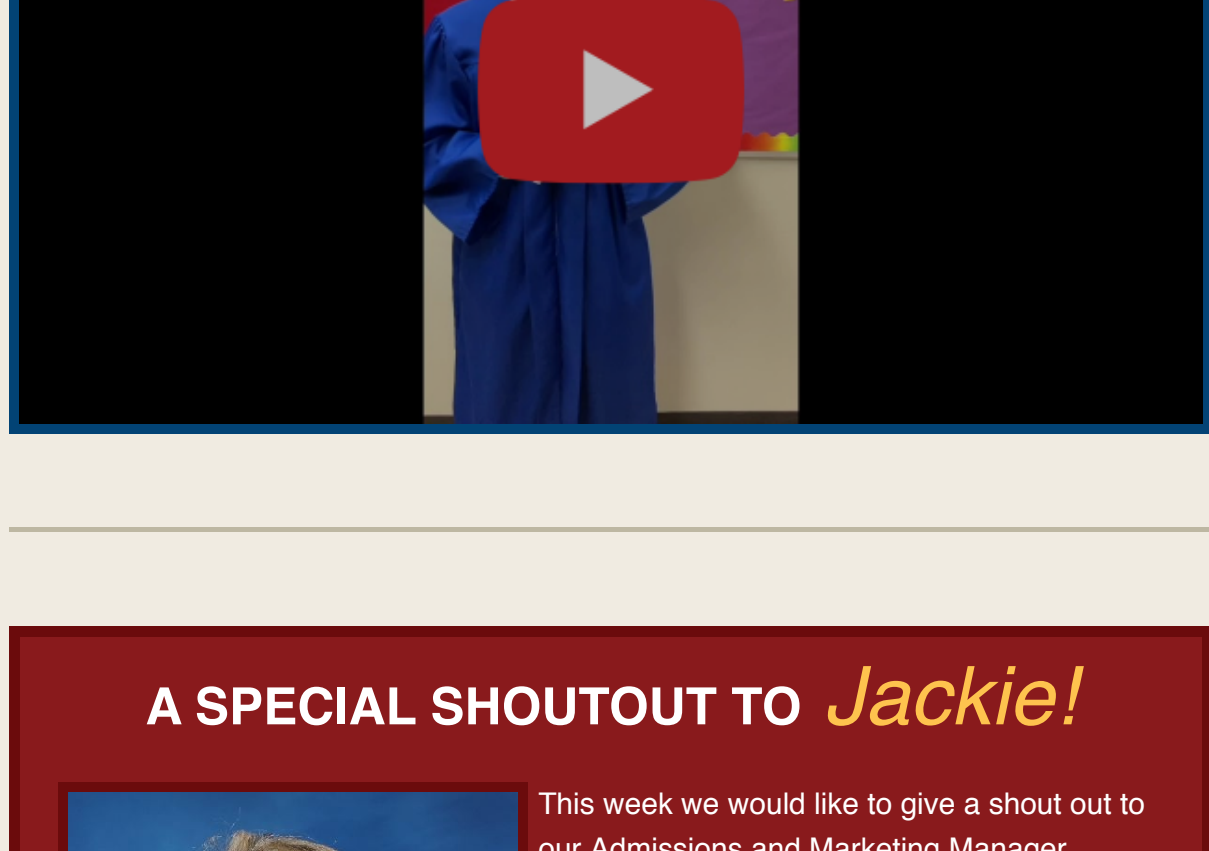
Students should take the time to properly read over all the instructions to fill out the forms and submit correctly. Please contact the Guidance Department if you have any questions.

BRONTE YEARBOOK

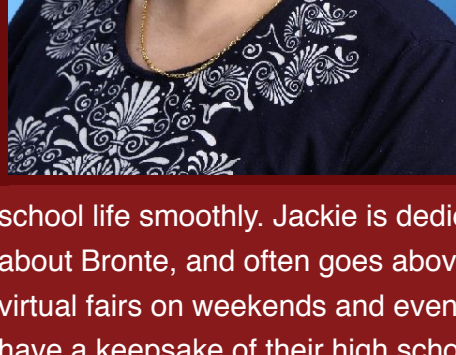
