VACCINATIONS AND ONTARIO'S REOPENING PLAN

With nearly two thirds of the eligible population vaccinated, and nearly a half million more people receiving vaccinations each day, Canada now leads the world in vaccine administration numbers. Bronte College is excited to welcome new and returning students in September, as each day in Ontario we see progressive steps towards a full re-opening.

Ontario's reopening schedule is based on the percentage of vaccinated residents. Currently, we are at Step 1, with some retail, and patio dining fully open. We expect to begin Step 2 as early as July 3rd, and Step 3 potentially as early as August, 2021.

Here is what the extra-curricular certificate program meant to our student body:

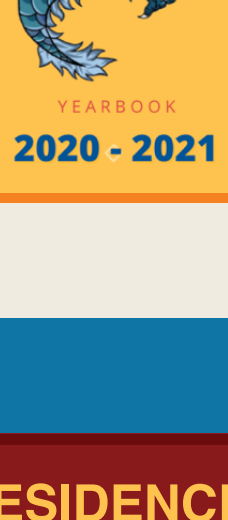

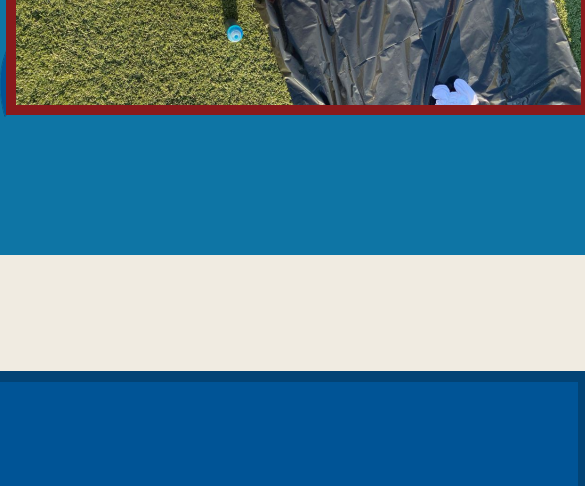
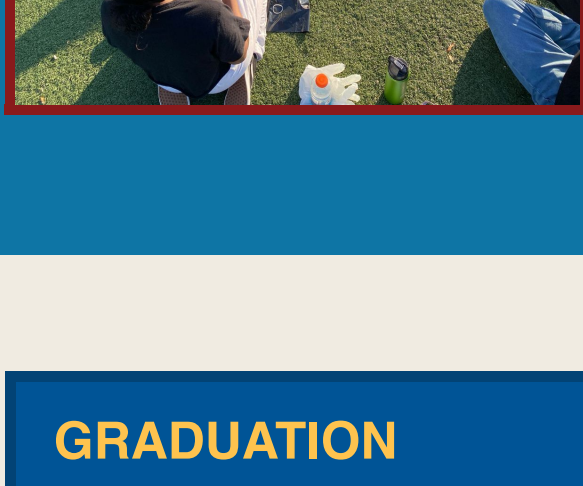
BRONTE YEARBOOK
