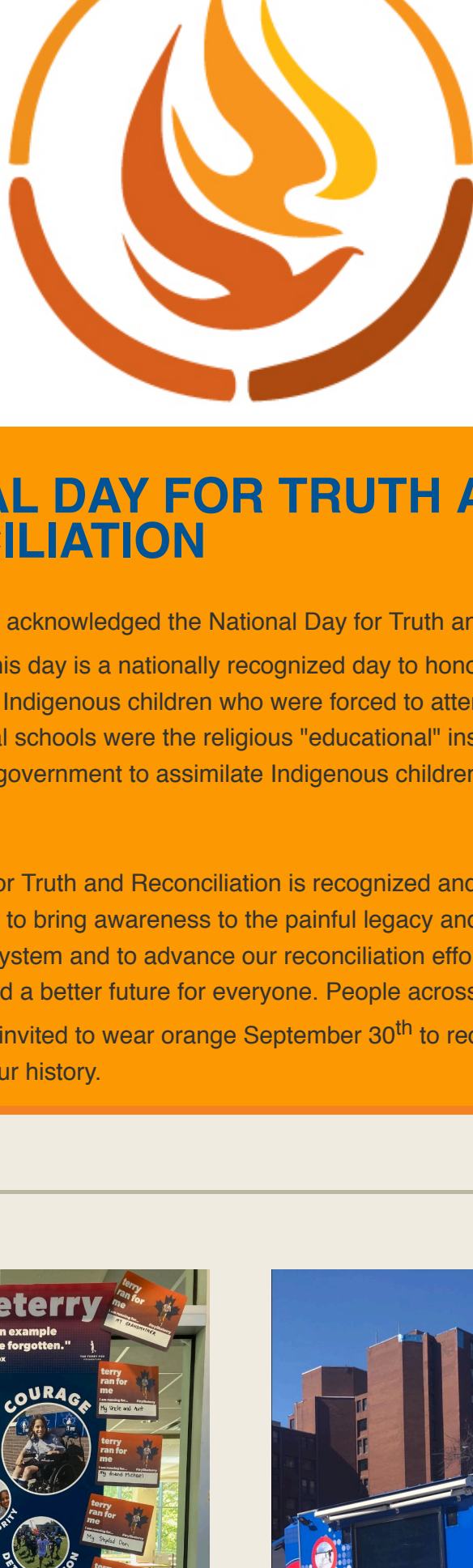
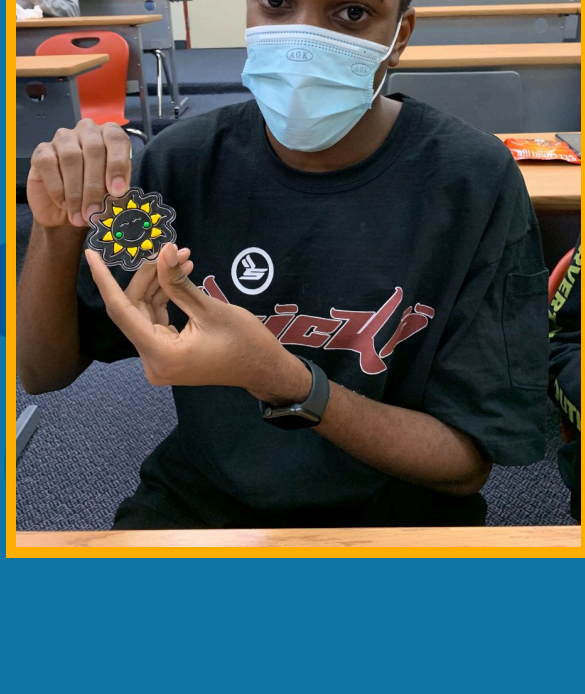
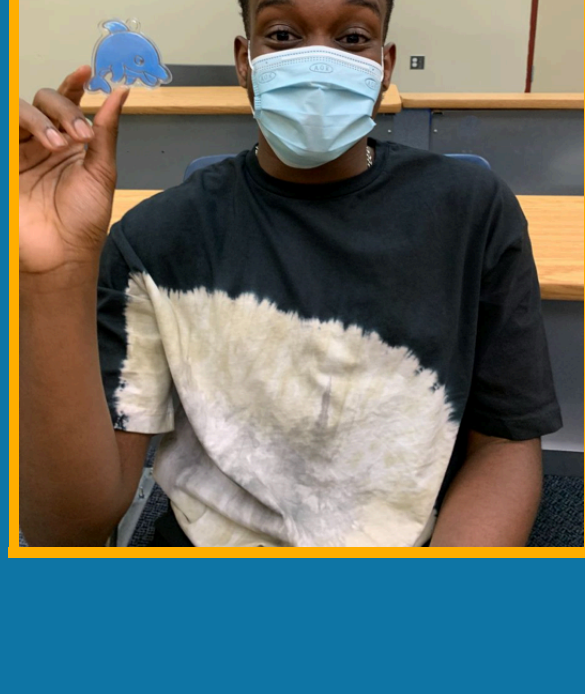
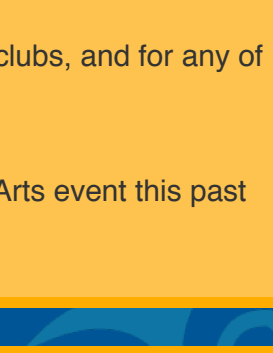
EXTRA-CURRICULAR CLUBS

Join the Team to receive updates or announcements for the clubs, and for any of the special events that will be hosted this year!

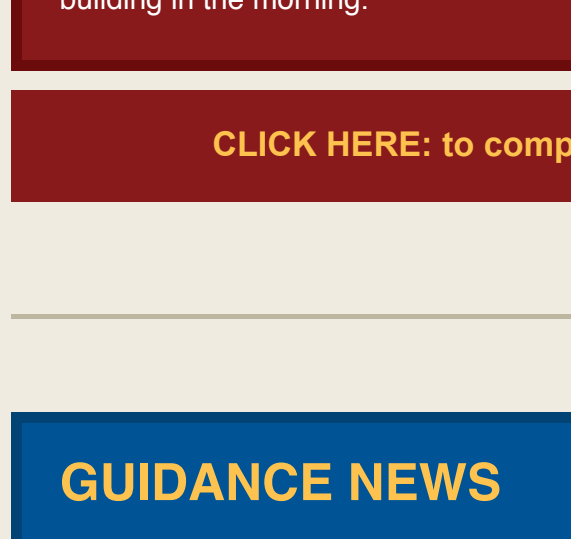
Students made some colourful stain glass key chains at the Arts event this past week.



NATIONAL DAY FOR TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION

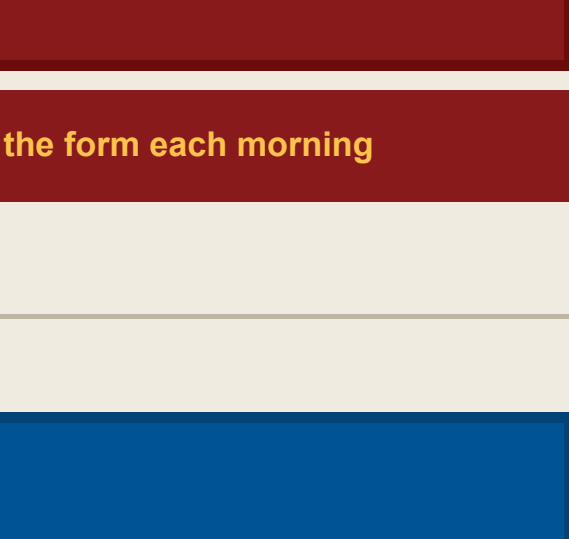
This week students acknowledged the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation on September 30th. This day is a nationally recognized day to honour the families and communities of the Indigenous children who were forced to attend residential schools. Residential schools were the religious "educational" institutions, established by the government to assimilate Indigenous children into Euro-Canadian culture.

The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation is recognized and observed throughout Canada to bring awareness to the painful legacy and impacts of the residential school system and to advance our reconciliation efforts with Indigenous communities to build a better future for everyone. People across Canada, including our students, were invited to wear orange September 30th to recognize and raise awareness about our history.

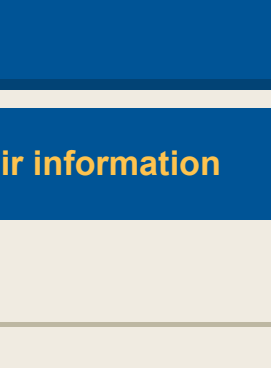

Bronte College University Fair - Virtual:

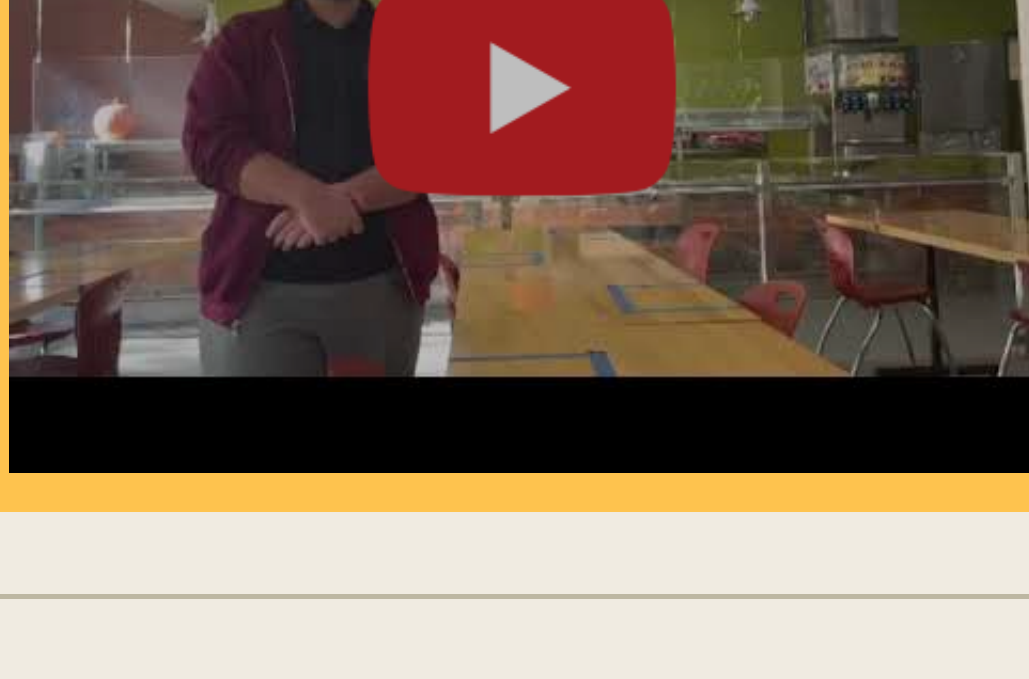

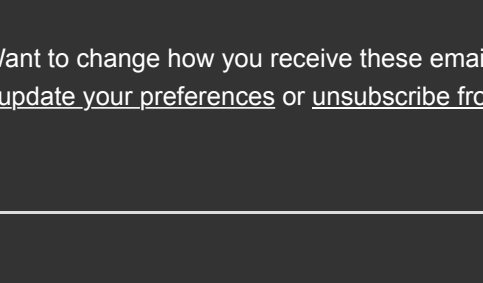

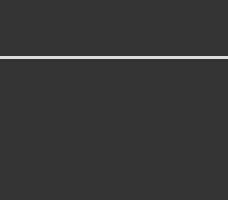
