

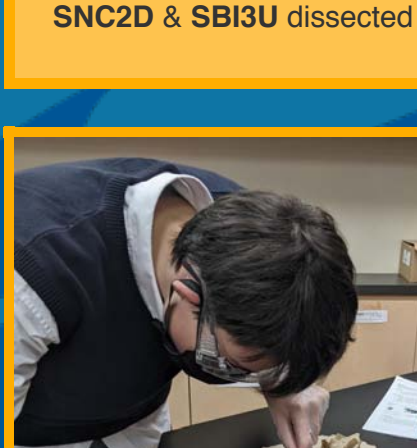
Dear Bronte Community,

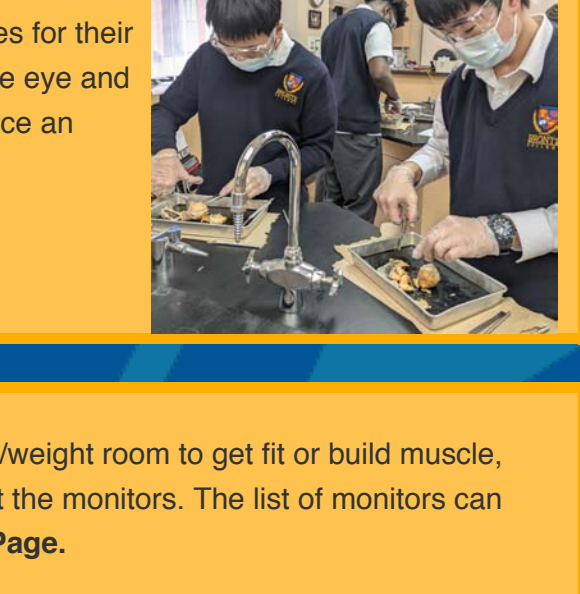
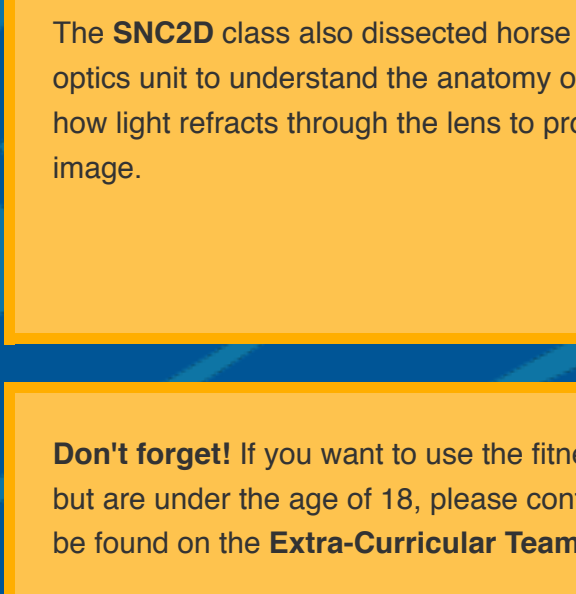
## WHAT'S HAPPENING ON CAMPUS



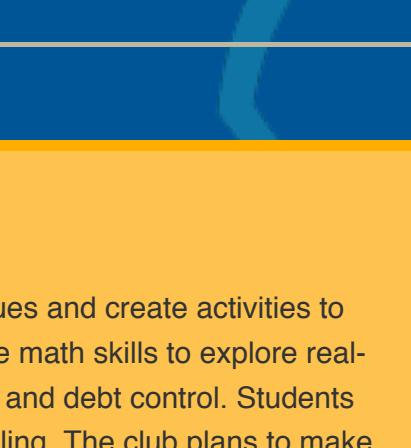
**The science classes are hard at work! Check out some of the highlights:**

The **SNC2D** class also dissected horse eyes for their optics unit to understand the anatomy of the eye and how light refracts through the lens to produce an image.

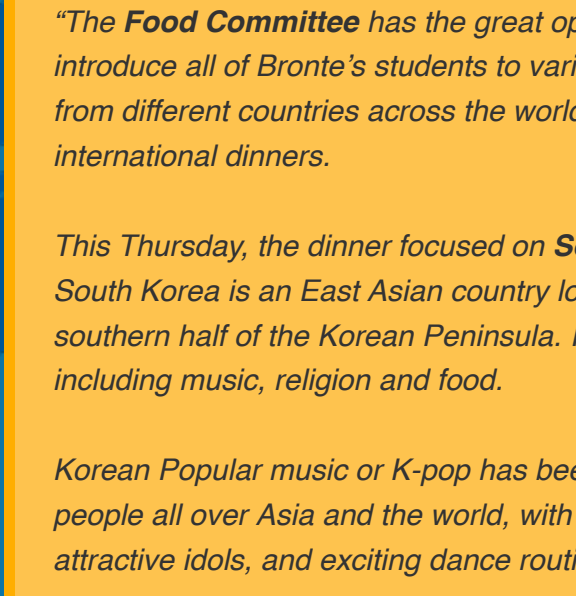

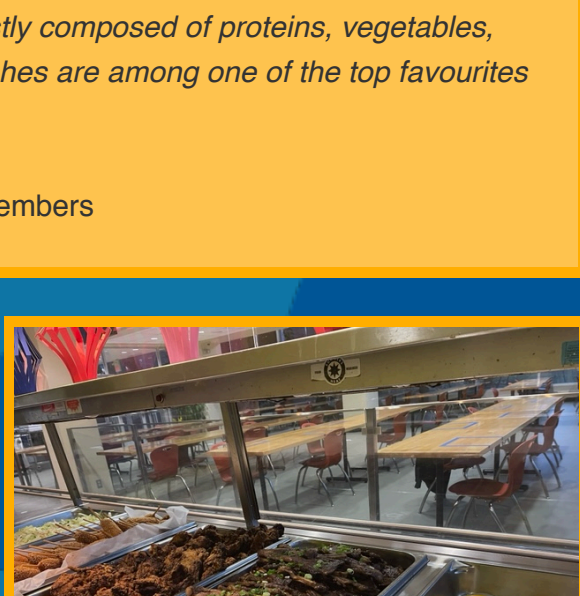
## CLUB NEWS

*"The **Food Committee** has the great opportunity to introduce all of Bronte's students to various food cultures from different countries across the world through special international dinners."*

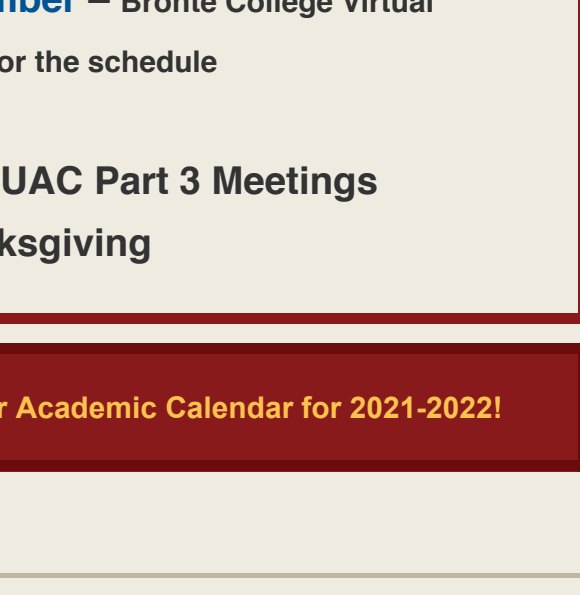
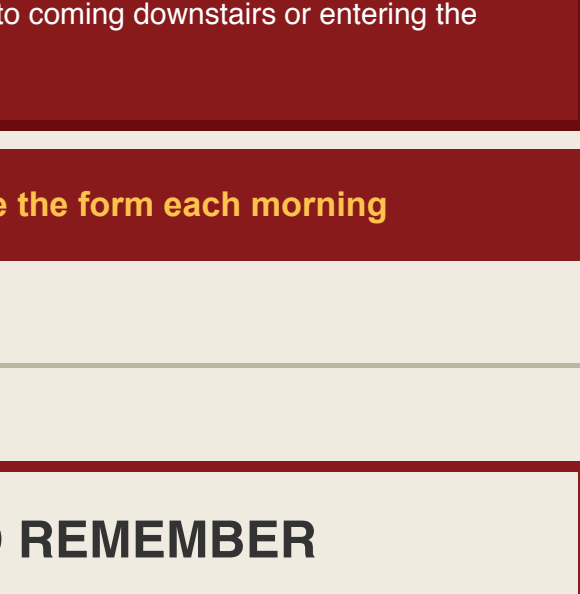
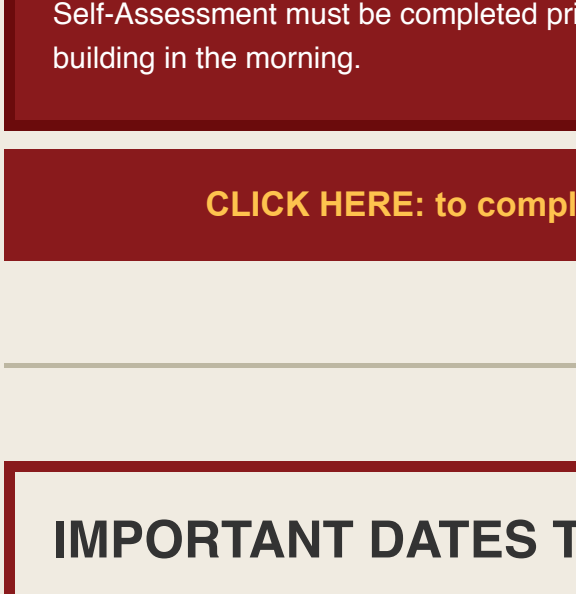
