



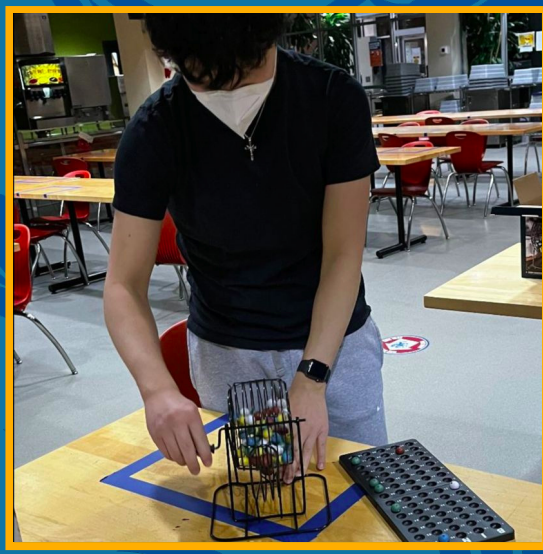
Dear Bronte Community,

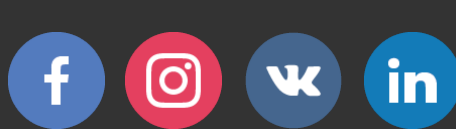
