Students now required to have a PCR test on re-entry to Canada in January 2022.

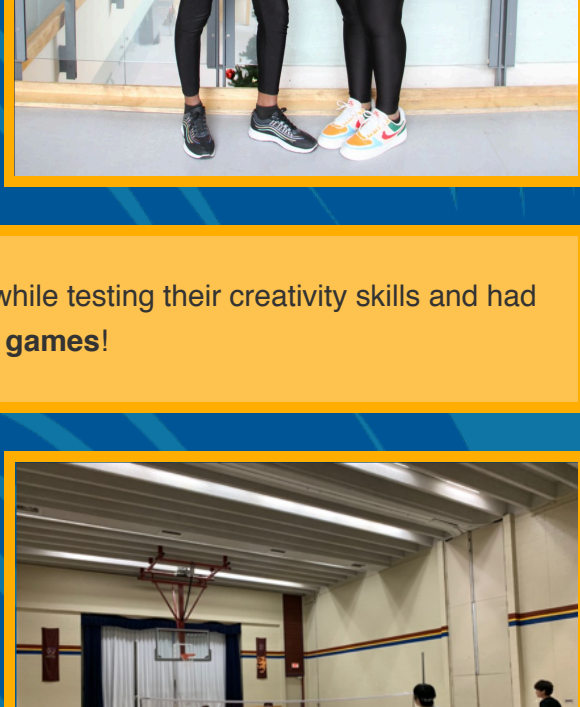
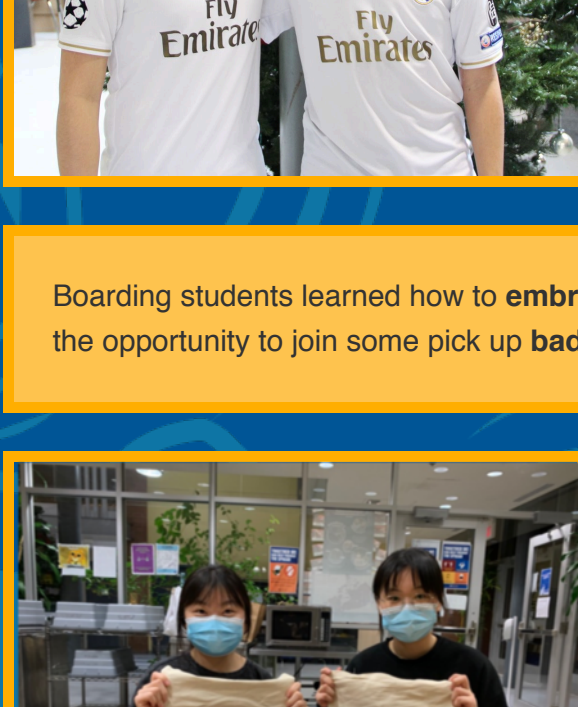

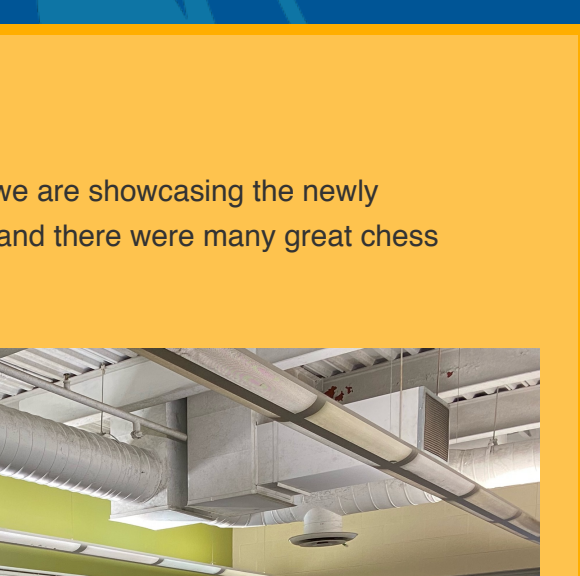
WHAT'S HAPPENING ON CAMPUS

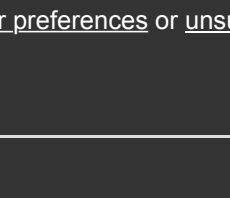
