



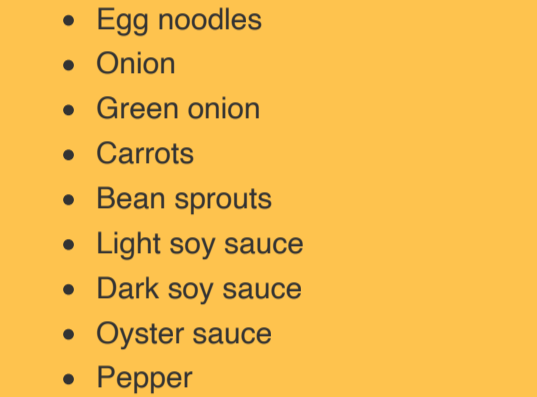
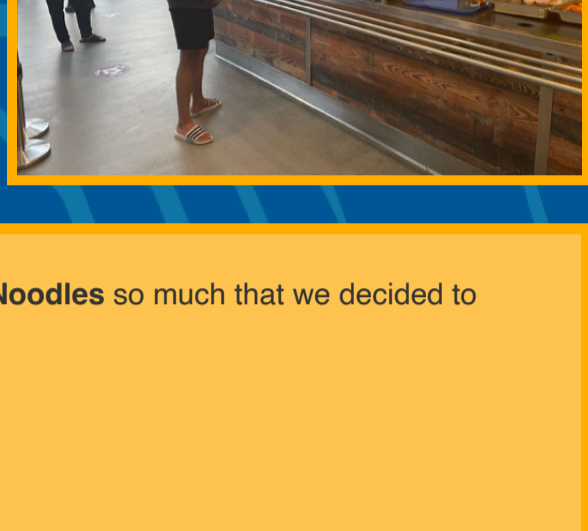

This week, the students enjoyed a scrumptious feast to celebrate the **New Lunar Year**. The grand meal included Whole roasted Pig, Smoked Duck with Maple Soy Glaze, Grilled Salmon in herb sauce, Chicken Fried Noodles, Stir Fried Vegetables, Korean rice cakes and Sesame Balls.



Our students enjoyed our **Chicken Fried Noodles** so much that we decided to share the recipe for others to try:

Ingredients

- Chicken
- Egg noodles
- Onion
- Green onion
- Carrots
- Bean sprouts
- Light soy sauce
- Dark soy sauce
- Oyster sauce
- Pepper
- Minced Garlic
- Sesame oil
- Sesame seeds

Method

- Cook marinated chicken until browned, remove from skillet.
- Add carrot and onion to the skillet and cook until the carrots are softened. Remove from skillet and set aside.
- Add sesame oil to the same skillet and fry noodles until they get crispy edges. Add carrots and onions back to the noodles and add in the chopped green onions.
- To create the sauce, combine soy sauce together with oyster sauce and garlic. Add stir to combine everything together. Remove from the heat and serve while everything is still warm.

Course Change Deadline

This is just a reminder that students are only allowed to change courses up to **February 14th, 2022**. The Guidance Department will try to accommodate your requests, but please understand many factors go into changing a course. The Guidance Department is not able to change a course that is mandatory to graduate or a course that is a pre-requisite or required course for your university program. Your course change must fit your timetable schedule. Please contact the Guidance Department if you need to change, drop, or add a course this week.

Supplementary Applications & Document Uploads

February is an important month for admission to universities. The Guidance Department will upload semester 1 final marks for all Grade 12 students on OUAC. Universities will be able to see these grades and could offer students with high Grade 12 and Grade 11 marks an early acceptance. Please note that supplementary applications and important documents must be uploaded before the end of February. It is the student's responsibility to regularly check their emails and student portals as well as communicate with the universities to ensure all important deadlines and document requirements are being met. 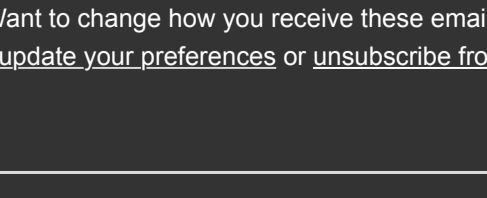
