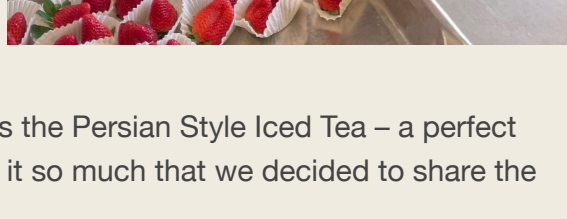
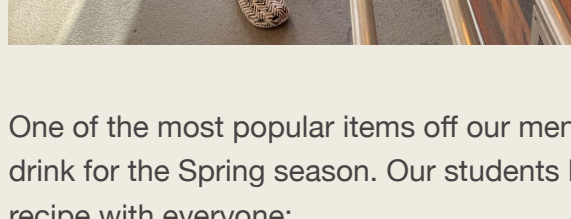

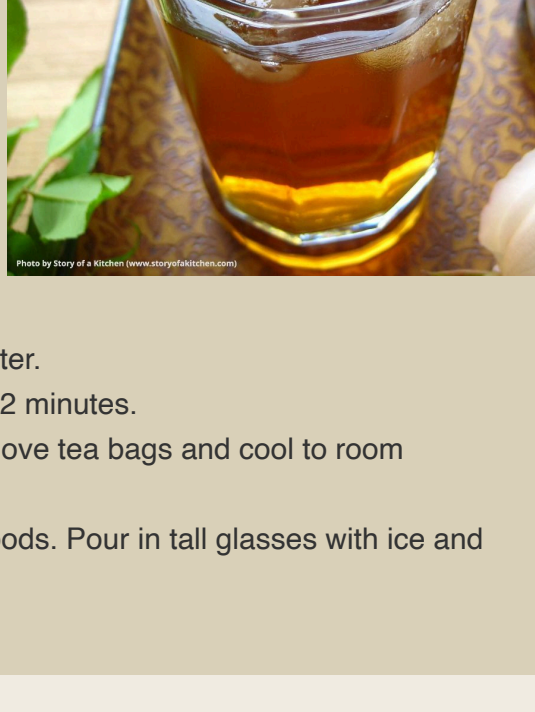
Persian-style iced tea with rosewater

Ingredients

- 3 ounces rose water
- 1-2 bags of black tea
- 3 cups of water
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 4 pods of green cardamom

Instructions

1. Brew the tea with 3 cups of boiling water.
2. Add cardamom pods and honey after 2 minutes.
3. Allow to steep for a few minutes. Remove tea bags and cool to room temperature.
4. Add rose water. Remove cardamom pods. Pour in tall glasses with ice and serve. Serves 3.

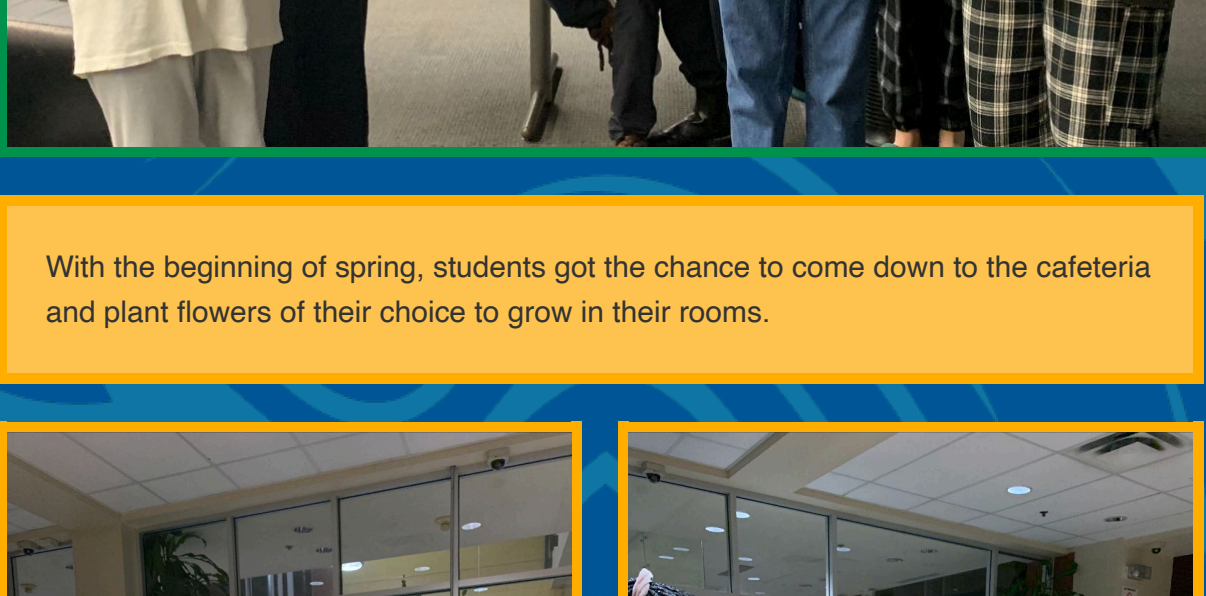
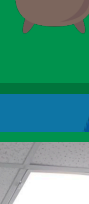


WHAT'S HAPPENING ON CAMPUS

St. Patrick's Day is a global celebration of Irish culture and is celebrated with parades, games, good luck charms, leprechaun stories, and all things green!

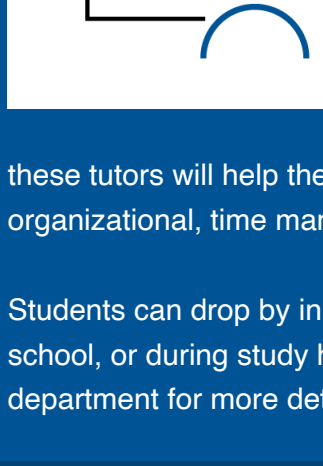


With the beginning of spring, students got the chance to come down to the cafeteria and plant flowers of their choice to grow in their rooms.
