

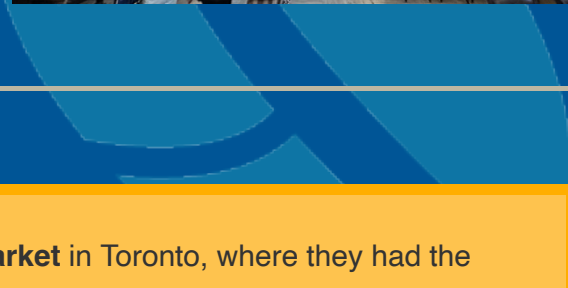
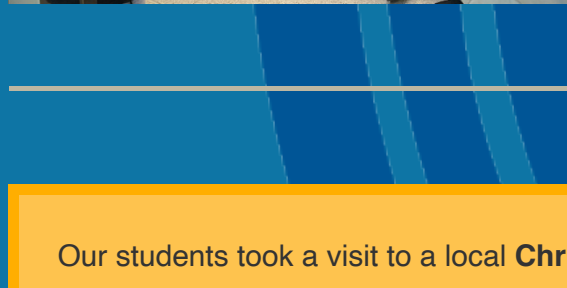
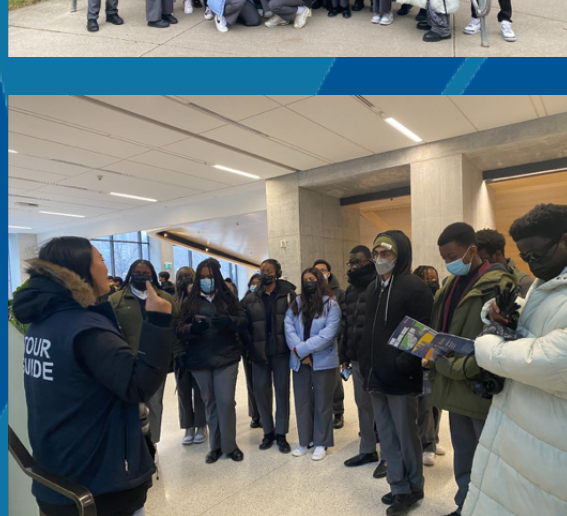

Our Student Food Committee will be hosting a "Taste of the Caribbean" dinner on Sunday, the 18th of December 2022.



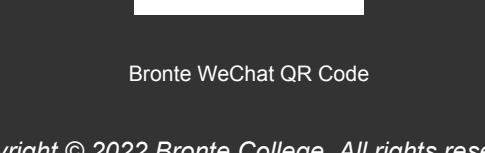
TRAVELLING TO CANADA

The Government of Canada lightens border measures as part of the transition to fewer restrictions.

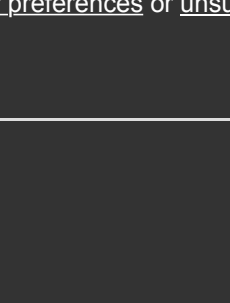
