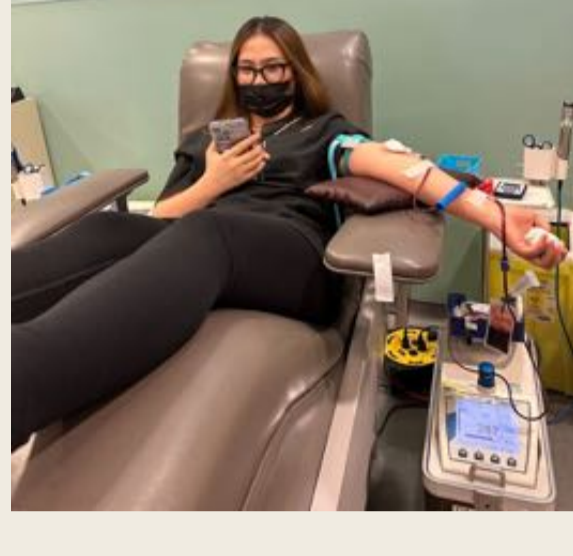
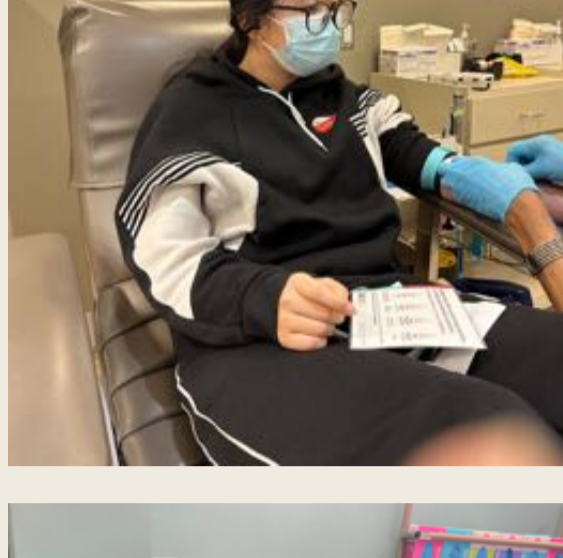

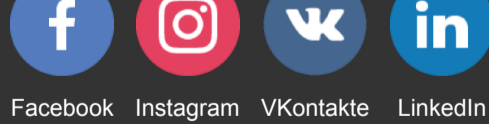
TRAVELLING TO CANADA
