MARCH 15, 1933 – SEPTEMBER 18, 2020

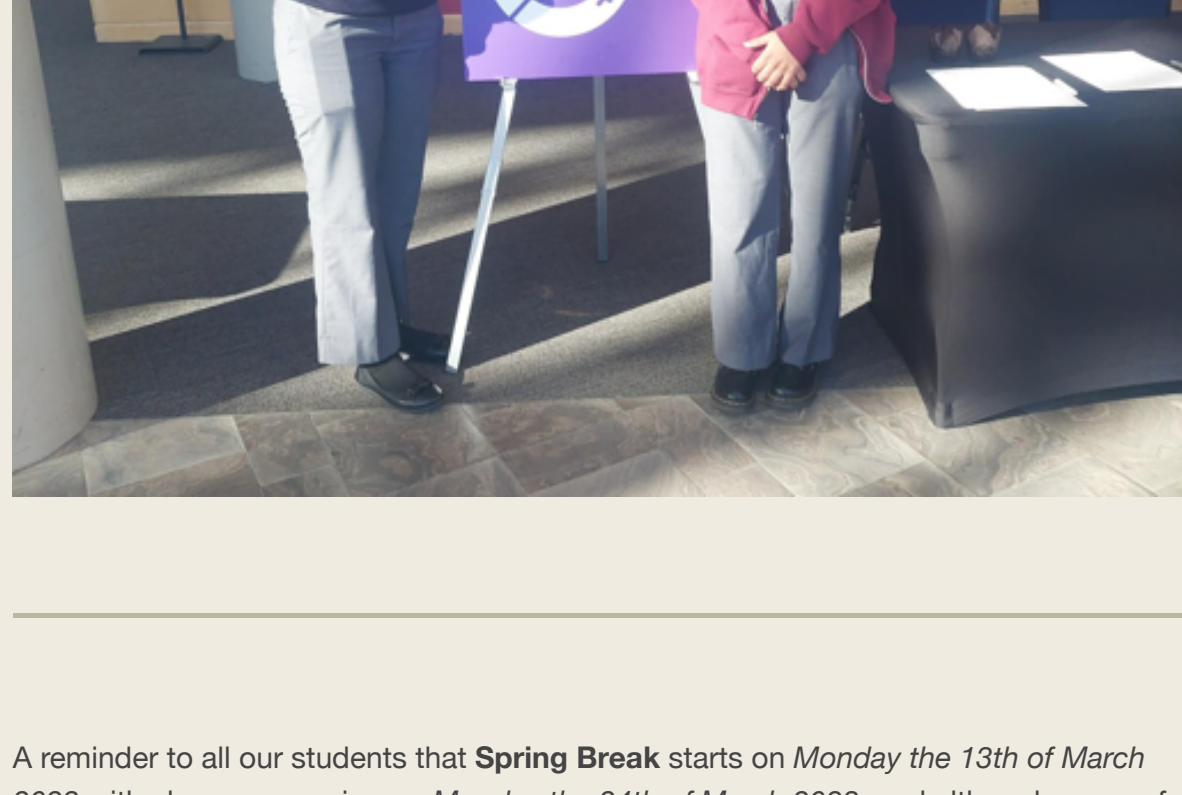
Ruth Bader Ginsburg battled and overcame sexism personally and professionally. She led the way for women's equality under the law.

She graduated first in her class in law school and became an accomplished civil rights lawyer and law professor. She was appointed as a Supreme Court Justice in the United States in 1993.

The "Notorious RBG" was a champion of equal rights, and much of the legal equality women have is due to her challenging the precedent that was set in the past. Later, she worked on equal rights for all, so people could choose and accomplish what they wanted to in life; no matter their gender, how they worship, what race they are, or who they love.

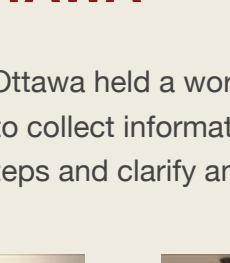

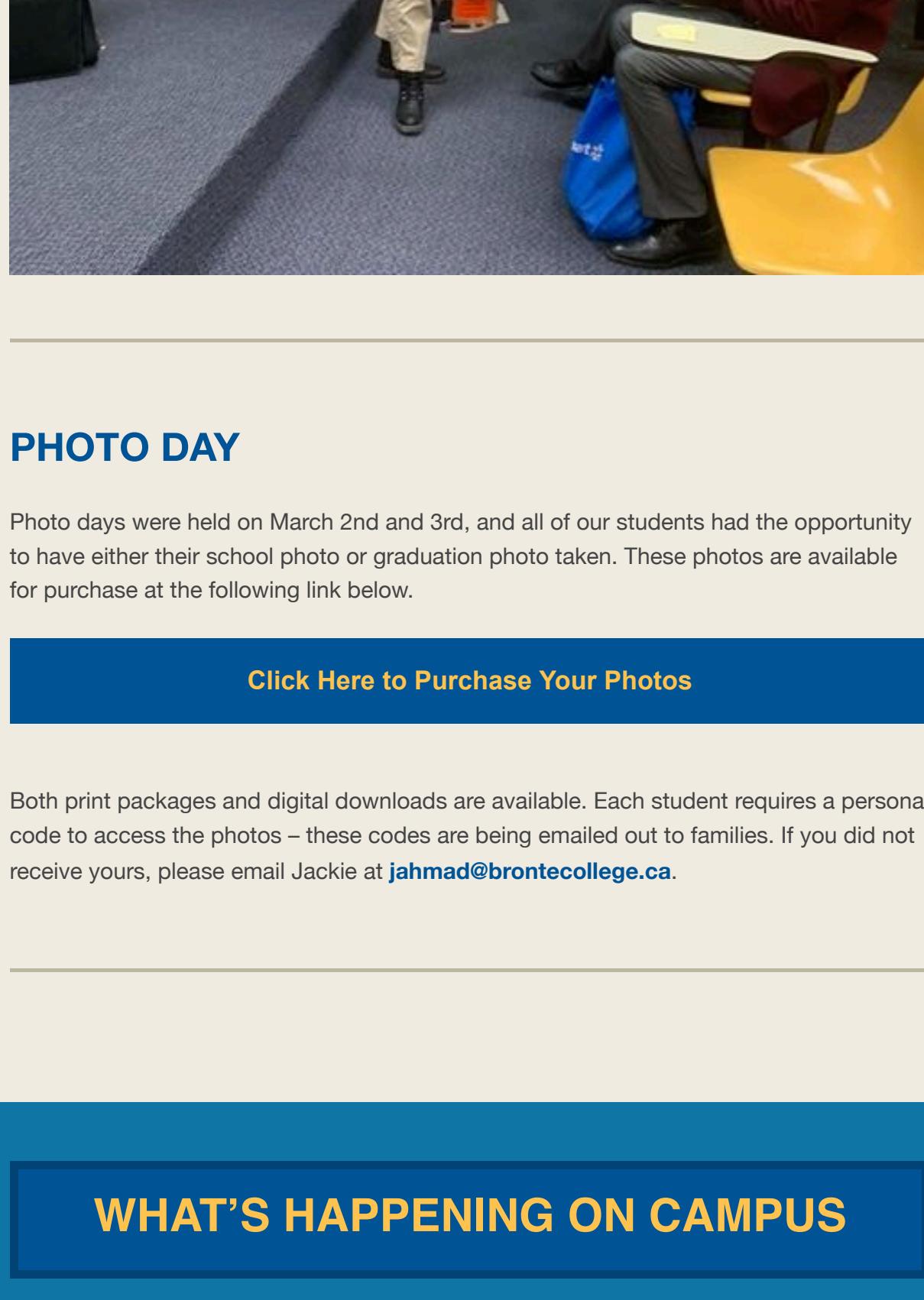
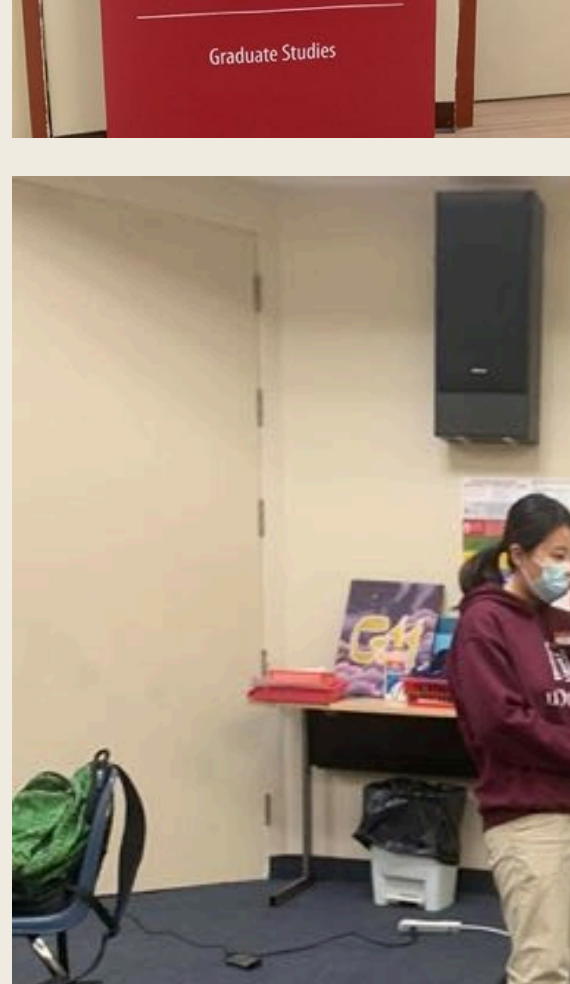


PHOTO DAY
