June - 29 – Graduation Ceremony

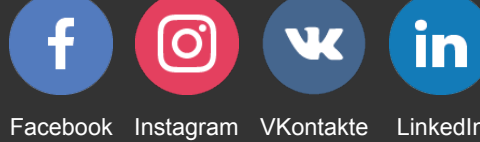

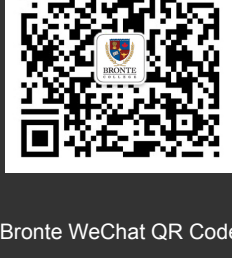
