## Scott Brison

Birth date: April 10, 1967 (still alive)
Summary: Scott Brison is a Canadian politician and businessman. He was a Member of Parliament for Kings-Hants from 1997 to 2019. Brison held various positions in the government, including President of the Treasury Board and Minister of Digital Government. He was also the first openly gay cabinet minister in Canadian

history.

• Importance: Scott Brison's significance lies in his role as a trailblazer for LGBTQ2S+ representation in Canadian politics. His visibility and success challenged stereotypes and paved the way for other LGBTQ2S+ individuals to pursue leadership roles in government and beyond.
