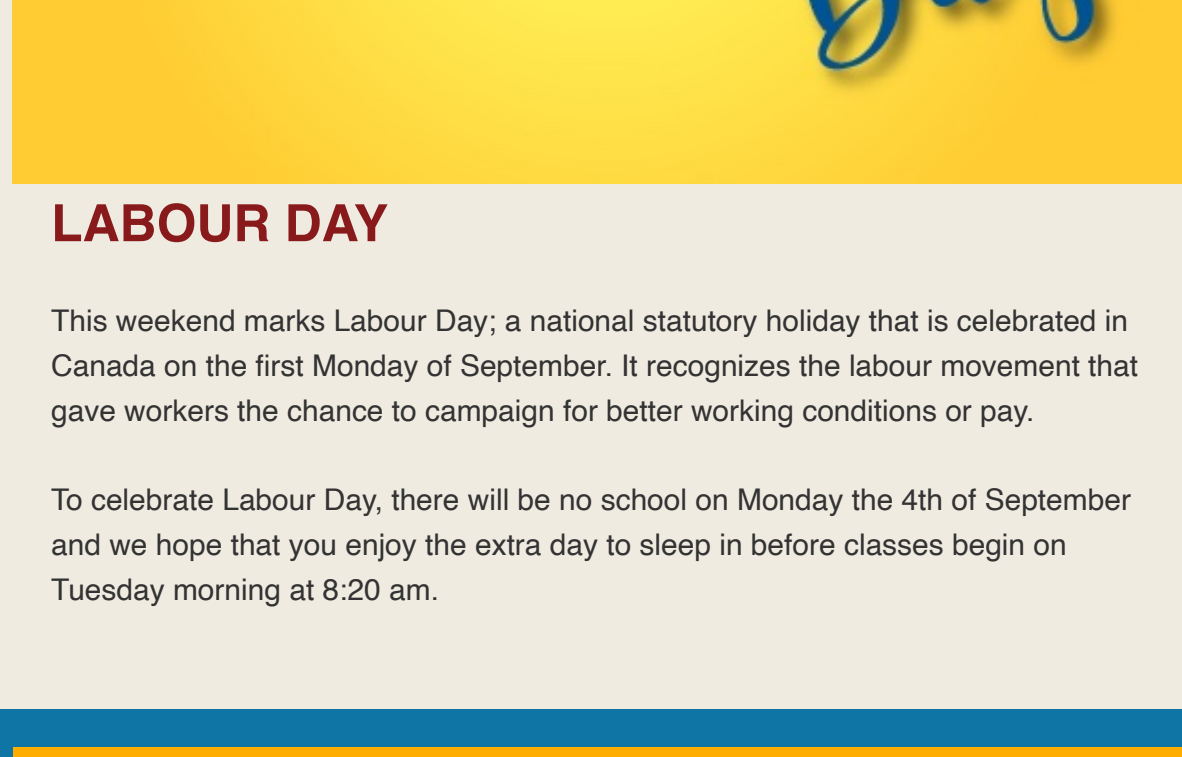
GRADE 9/10 PARENTS RESPONSE REQUIRED

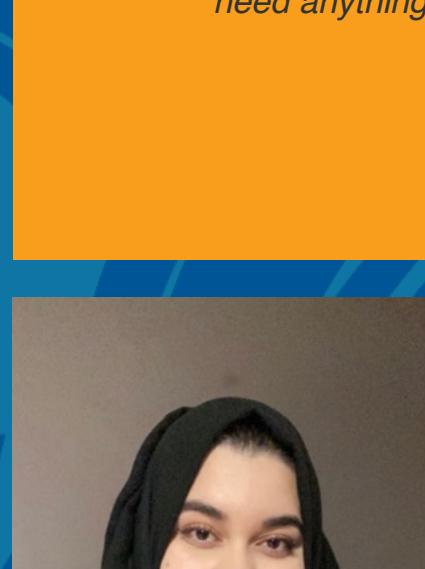

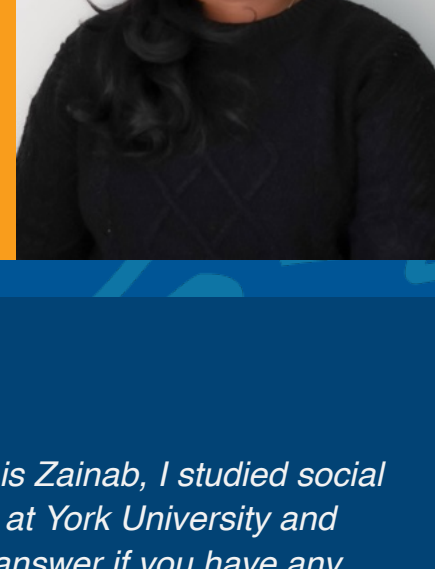


Mukesh

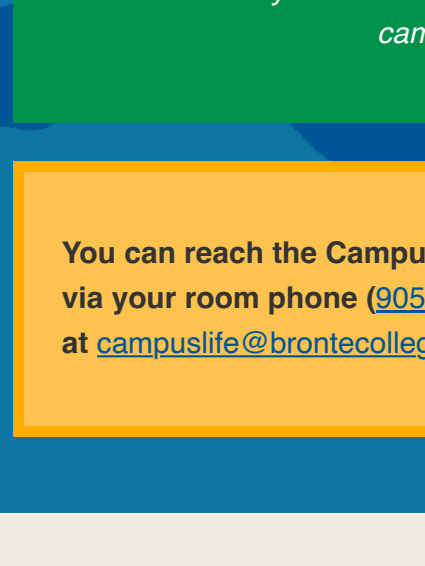
Pratima

"Hey, I am Pratima. I am a fan of Photography, drones, travel & food and am super excited to get to know everyone. If you need anything, don't be shy to ask!"



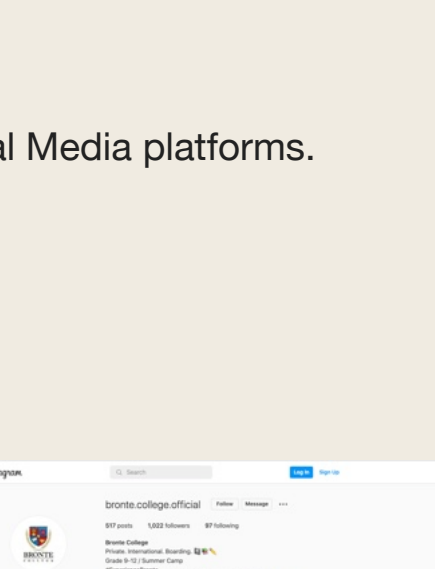
Zainab

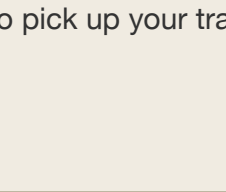
Abubakar

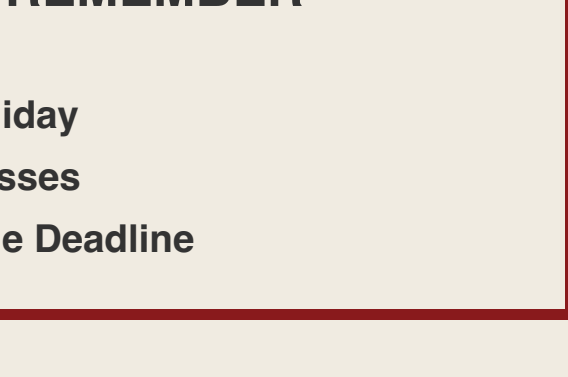
