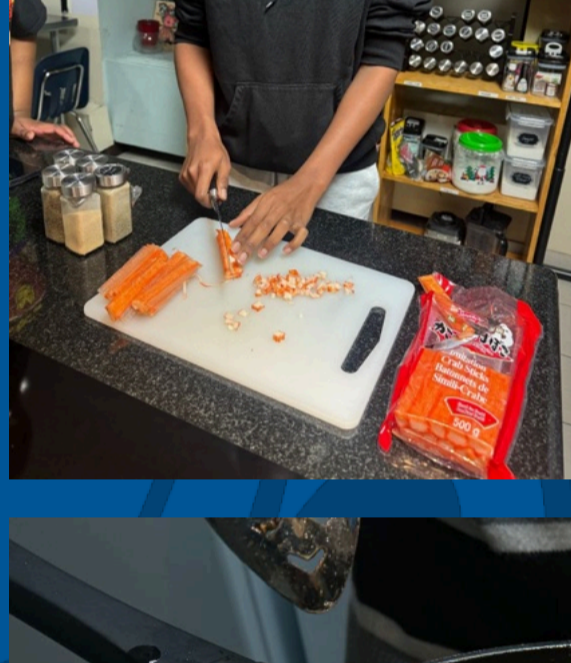




A reminder to all students who are staying back on Campus for the Winter break, kindly message the Campus Life Team or the Front Desk on TEAMS with any questions or concerns.
