

Winter break starts next week and while many of our students are busy preparing to go home, those staying back on campus will have plenty of exciting activities, trips, and delicious meals to look forward to.

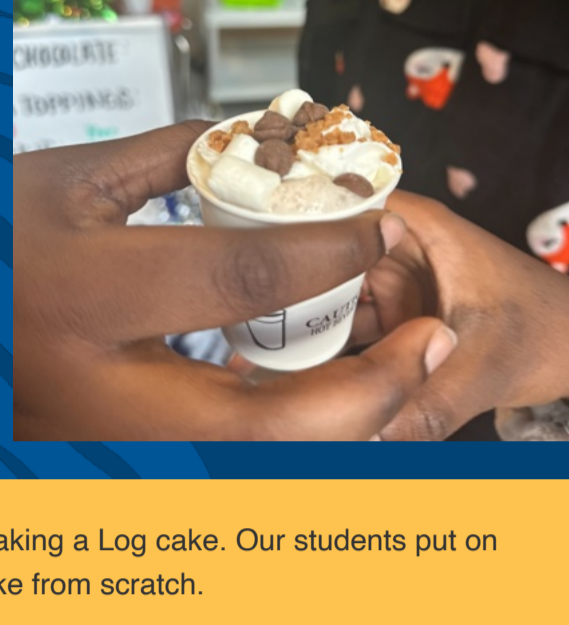


## CAMPUS LIFE

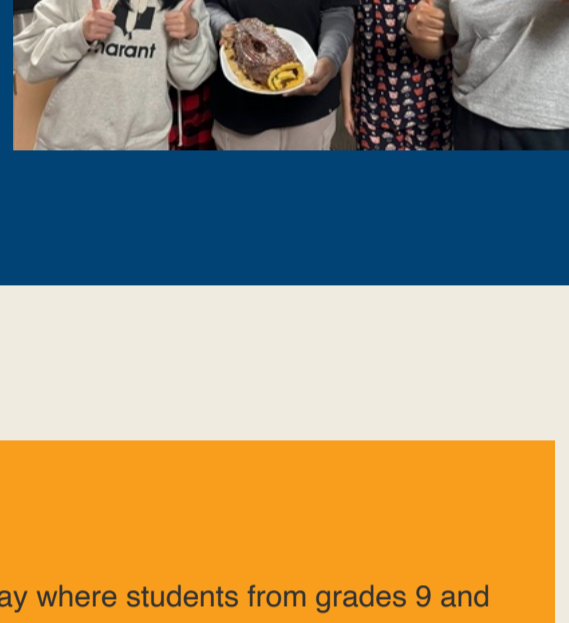
A big congratulations to our Green House team for achieving first place in November! The team enjoyed a celebratory pizza party.

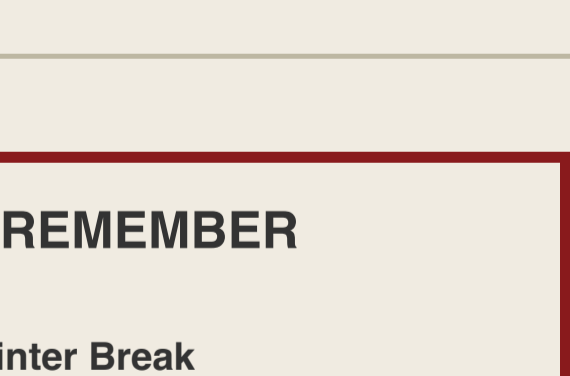
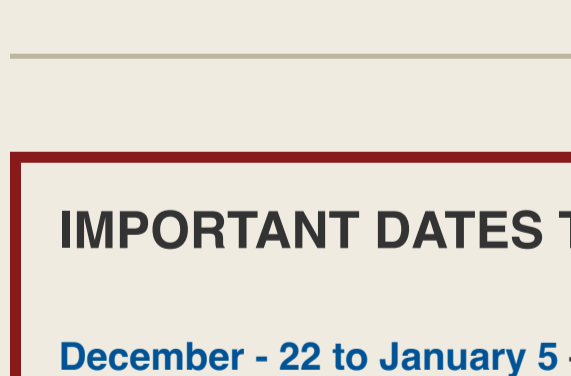

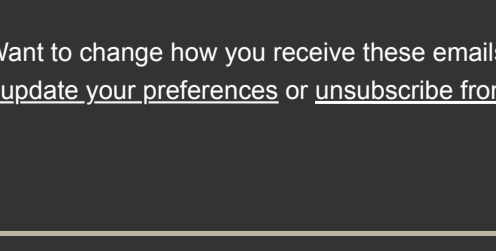
