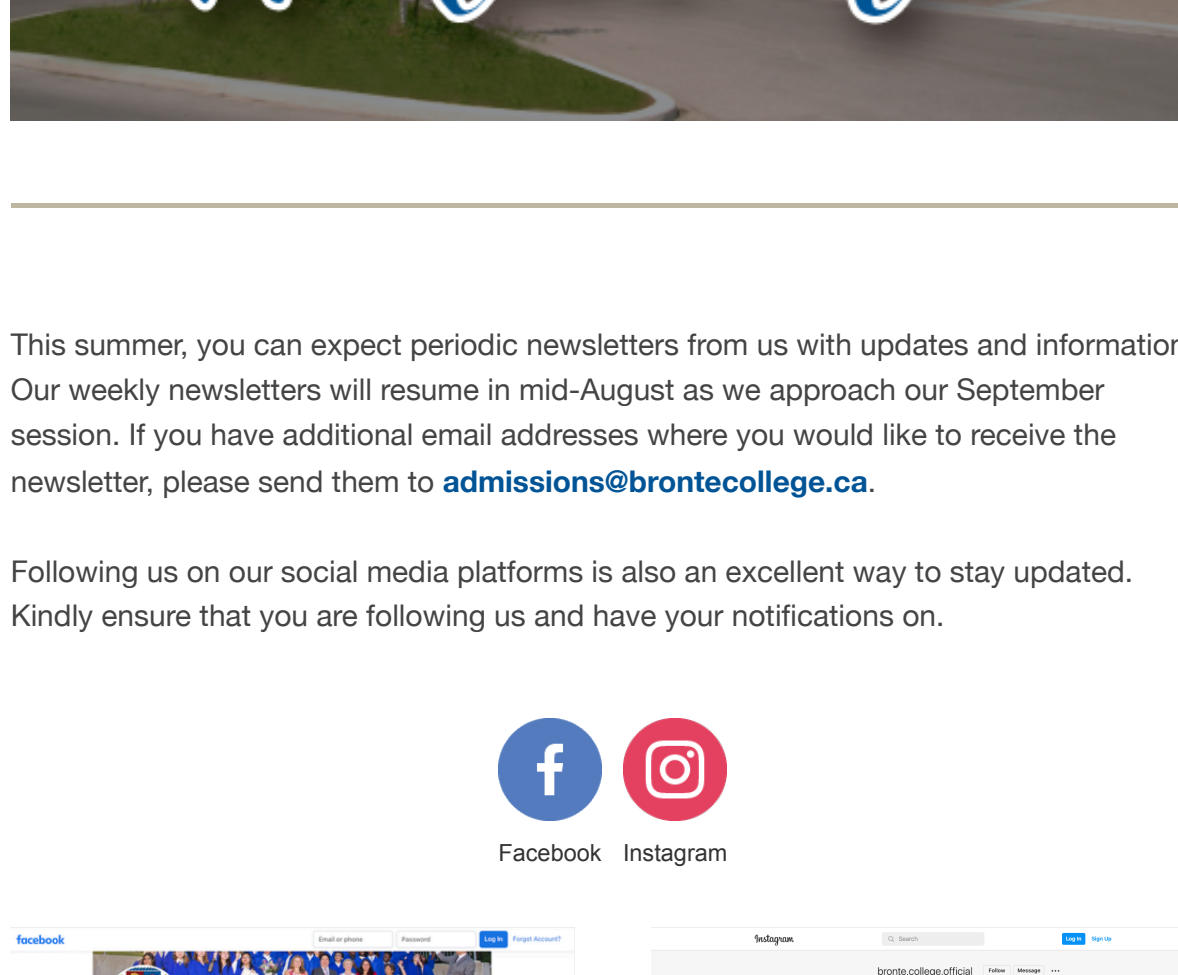

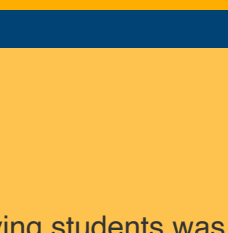

Welcome to all our new students and their families, as well as our returning students and families. We are excited for another year of learning at Bronte College!

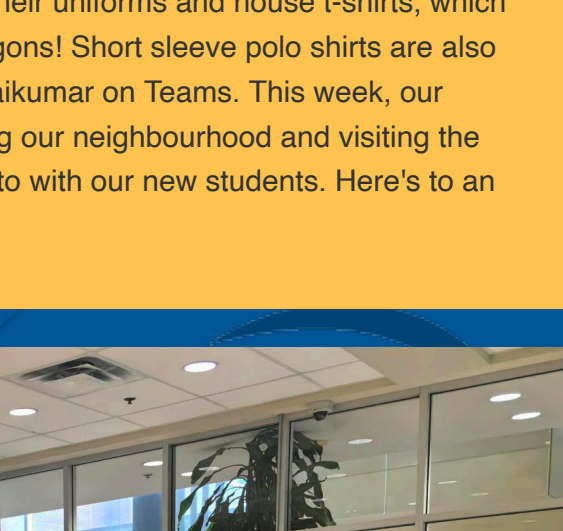
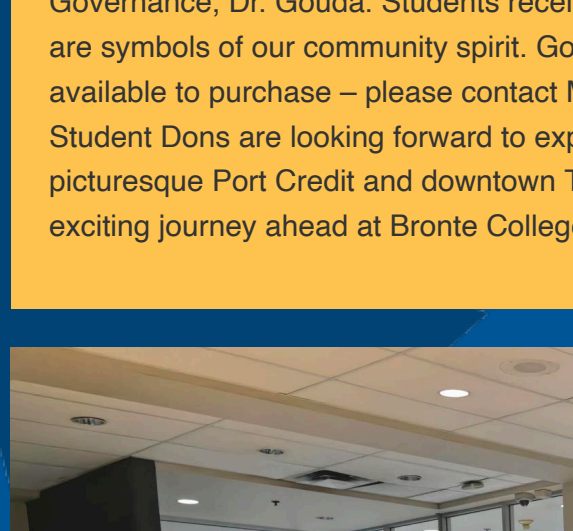
