A special shout out to our student Pok, who finished in 73rd place out of over 400 competitors.

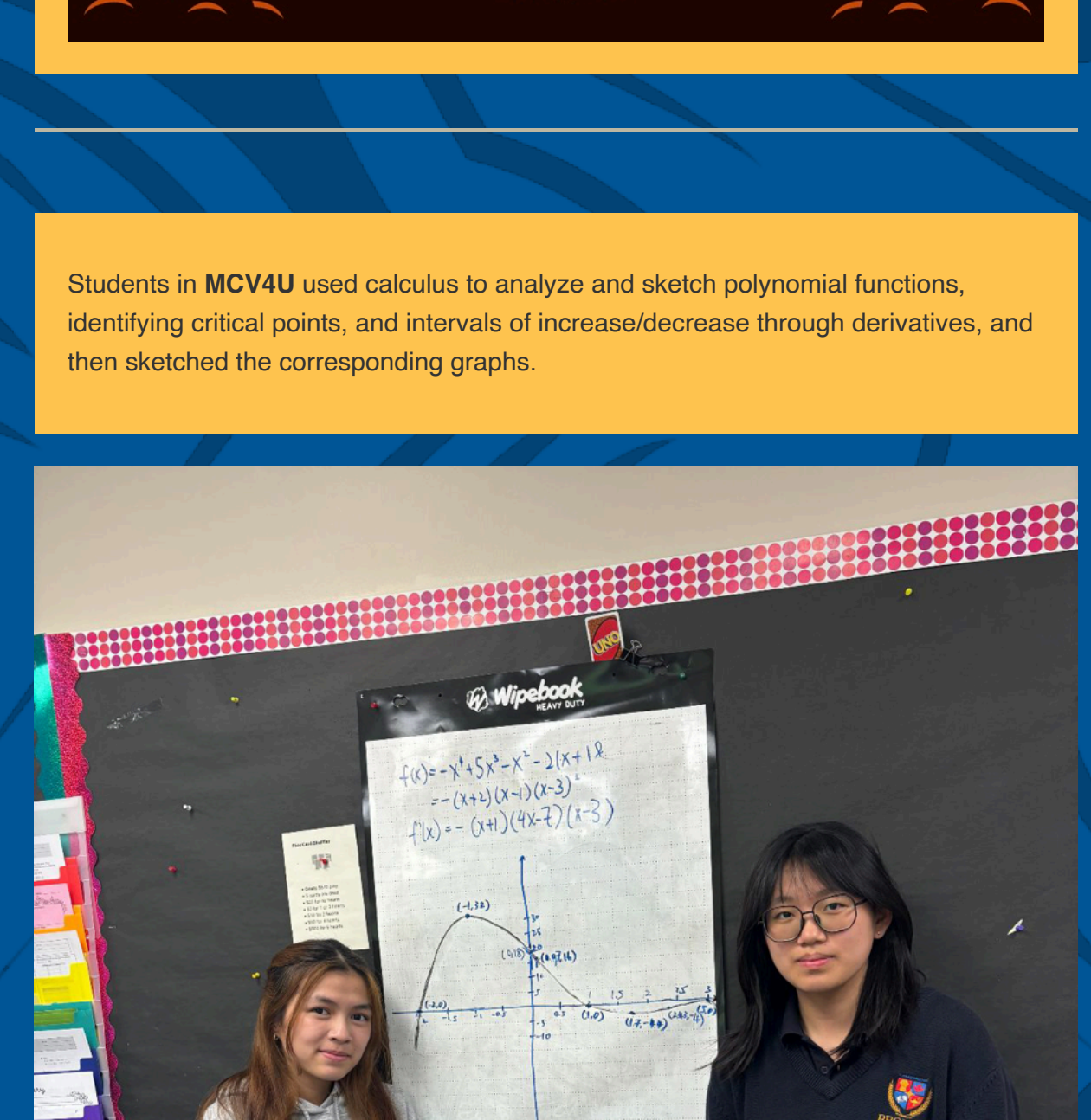

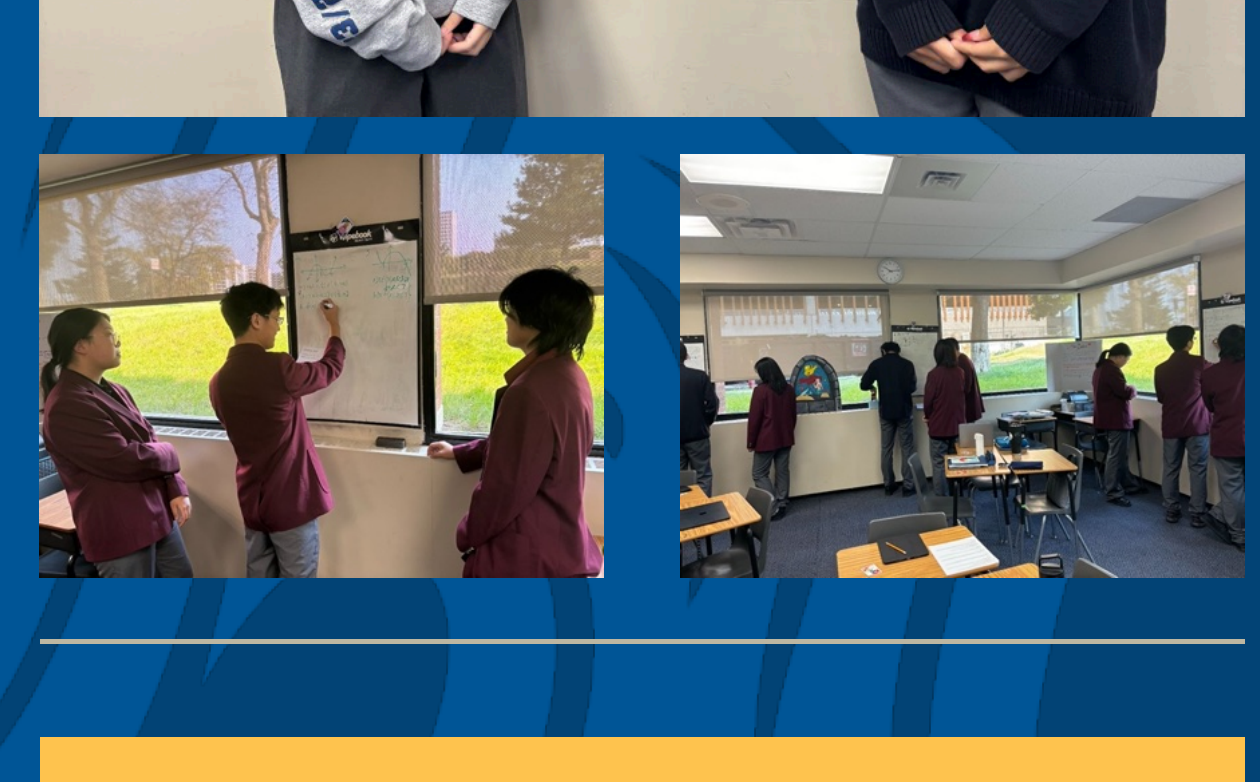
### WHAT'S HAPPENING ON CAMPUS

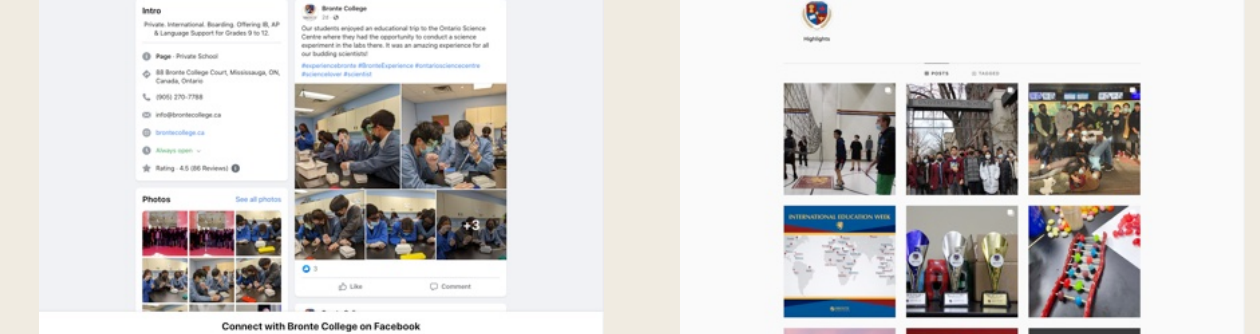
